

## Freight Rail Sets New Record with Coal to Maputo

Transnet Freight Rail achieved an all time record of 30 coal trains to TCM (Mozambique Railways and Harbours) last week. This equates to some 50 000 tons railed in one week as opposed to an average 25 000 tons per week.

Fuzile Magwa, Freight Rail's Regional Operating Executive for the Eastern Region, attributed the success to the stakeholder collaboration initiative between Freight Rail, Grinrod and CFM/TCM railways. "This is indeed a remarkable achievement and it is an encouraging response to the present global economic downturn which poses a great challenge to our business", said Magwa.
