- 8.11 All demolition, loading and removal operations must be strictly in accordance with the Health & Safety Act (Act 85 of 1983) (Annexure "B" will be the successful tenderer/s own compliance.)
- 8.12 Demolition, loading and removal operations shall be carried out in such a manner that fires do not occur. Fire fighting equipment is to be workable and available at all times at the work site to prevent fires.
- 8.13 The successful tenderer will be responsible for the site to be in a safe and tidy condition throughout the demolition, loading and removal period. Site inspection will be from time to time and if not in a tidy and safe condition, it must be restored immediately to the satisfaction of Transnet's representation.
- 8.14 Insurance against accident and 3rd party loss will be for the successful tenderer's account.
- 8.15 The railway site is to be regarded as operational at all times.

BROAD BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT (BBBEE)

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it is strongly of the opinion that all South African Business Enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past.

Transnet will therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will endeavour to do business with local business enterprises that possess a BBBEE "recognition level" of **at least a level 5**. Transnet urges Tenderers (large enterprises and QSE's - see below) to have themselves accredited by any one of the various Accreditation Agencies available, who do their BBBEE ratings in accordance **with the latest Codes (i.e. those promulgated on 9 February 2007) and whose names appear on the present ABVA (Association of BEE Verification Agencies) – "List of Full Members" as displayed on the ABVA website (www.abva.co.za)**.
