7.1 It will be a condition of any contract awarded as a result of this tender that the tendered price will remain firm for

the duration of the contract.

8. SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

- **8.1** The tender document must be properly witnessed and signed.
- 8.2 An option date must be furnished.
- **8.3** The complete set of tender documents must be returned.
- **8.4** Incomplete tenders will not be considered in the award of any business. Failure to observe these requirements will result in the tender being overlooked.
- 8.5 The successful tenderer will be responsible for the safe removal of the wagons on either rail/road trucks for the transportation to their desired destination. It is to be noted that these wagons cannot be moved on rail as they are no longer "road worthy".
- 8.6 Tenderers are invited to visit the sites at their own cost, to fully acquaint themselves regarding the location, conditions etc. at the sites where the wagons are staged, must be undertaken before submitting their tender. The fact of them tendering will be regarded as an acknowledgement that this has been done.

- N.B Tenderers are to note that if the site meetings are not attended their tender will not be considered.
- 8.9 If wagons are to be cut to enable removal all cutting, loading and other operations must be strictly in accordance with the Health and Safety Act 85 of 1993 (Act 85 of 1993).
- **8.10** Cutting operations shall be carried out in such a manner that fires do not occur. Fire fighting equipment is to be available at all times at the work sites to prevent fires.
- **8.11** All high voltage lines are to be regarded as alive at all times. Cutting operations may not be carried out closer than twenty metres from any high voltage line.
- 8.12 All rail lines are to be regarded as operational at all times. Special permission must be obtained to facilitate cutting operations on Transnet premises.

- **8.13** The successful tenderer will be responsible for the cutting sites to be in a safe and tidy condition throughout the contract period. The sites will be inspected and if found not to be in this condition all operations will be stopped until the sites are restored to the required standard. Site rehabilitation will be required to clear oil spillage and waste. Related costs must be included in the tendered price.
- **8.14** The tender provides for the purchasing of NG Wagons as and where staged in the Eastern Cape Region.
 - 8.15 Insurance against accidents and 3rd party loss will be for the successful tender's account.
 - 8.16 The tenderer will be required to source his own workforce. Sleeping accommodation not on Spoornet premises, eating area, toilets and showers must be provided by the tenderer.
- **8.17** The tender provides for the purchasing and or cutting-up (if applicable) at the sites. The sites must be regarded as without gas lines, oxygen tanks, office & facilities etc. Gas/ oxygen lines to be installed must conform to the stipulated requirements for such equipment. - **8.18** All transport companies, sub-contractors and agents of the successful tenderer must be approved at all times by Transnet prior to them being allowed to visit and or work on Transnet sites. - 9.3 Provide own living quarters (if necessary), toilet and washing facilities, clean drinking water, etc. for his labourers.
- 9.4 Clean up and remove all debris from the sites at his own cost at the end of the contract.
- 9.5 Keep the sites in a neat and safe condition at all times. If the site is considered to be unsafe and untidy Transnet reserves the right to stop the cutting operation until the situation is rectified by the successful tenderer.

- 11.3 The successful tenderer will not be allowed to cut and remove the wagons before payment has been received.

12. VALUE ADDED TAX:

12.1 Tenderers are to note that Value Added Tax ruling at the date of payment will be levied by Transnet Ltd. and will be added to the price/s quoted.

13. PRICES SUBJECT TO CONFIRMATION:

13.1 A tender with prices subject to confirmation will not be considered.

14. INTEREST:

14.1 Attention is directed to the fact that if payment is not received within the stipulated period monthly compounded interest on all amounts payable in accordance with the payment conditions contained herein will be recovered at the prime interest rate determined by the Standard Bank of S.A, plus 1 %.

15. ALTERATIONS MADE BY TENDERERS:

15.1 All alterations made by Tenderers to their tendered price/s prior to the submission of their tender documents must be made by deleting the incorrect figure/s and words and by inserting the correct figure/s and words against the items concerned.

17. CONDITION OF THE MATERIAL:

- 17.1 Tenderers are expressly notified that the wagons are offered "as is" at the center/s where available and Transnet Ltd. accepts no responsibility whatsoever with respect to the accuracy of the description given in this tender or the condition of the Wagons. Prospective tenderers must, therefore, satisfy themselves in regard to the description, condition, model, etc. of the wagons tendered for, and the fact of their tendering will be regarded as an acknowledgement that this has been done.
- 17.2 In the event of a successful tenderer's refusal to fulfill his obligation against a tender submitted based on the argument that the description of the wagons does not comply with the article or condition thereof, such tenderer will not be entitled to rely on misrepresentation by Transnet Ltd. as it is a condition of this tender that prospective tenderers must inspect the wagons before submission of a tender.

18. REMOVAL PERIOD:

- 18.1 The successful tenderer will be required to remove the wagons within the period as tendered per clause 10. If the wagons are not removed within this period, it will be considered as warehoused by Transnet Ltd. and the successful tenderer will be liable for warehouse charges laid down in the Official Goods Tariff Book of Transnet Ltd.
- 18.2 At any time after the wagons are considered to be warehoused, Transnet Ltd. may call upon the purchaser in writing to remove the wagons within a further period specified in the notice, and if he fails to comply with the terms of the notice Transnet Ltd. may sell the wagons on what it considers to be the best terms and out of the proceeds of the sale pay itself and if this monies are insufficient to cover the warehouse charges the purchaser shall remain liable for the balance.

19. EXPORT PERMIT:

19.1 The onus will be upon tenderers who intend to export the wagons to establish from the Director General, Industries, Commerce and Tourism, Pretoria prior to the submission of their tender whether or not an export permit will be granted for the wagons purchased against this tender.

20. ACCEPTANCE OF TENDERS:

20.1 Transnet Ltd. may in its sole and unfettered discretion adjudicate upon the offers which are received pursuant to this tender, in whole or in part, as it deems necessary. Should no offer be received, which Transnet in its discretion deems acceptable in whole or in respect of any one or more of several parts, Transnet shall have the right without notice to withdraw this tender and/or decline to accept any tender. In such event, no liability of any nature will attach to Transnet.

25.1 If a tenderer withdraws or purports to withdraw or varies his tender within the period for which he has agreed that it shall remain open for acceptance, Transnet Ltd. will if it does not exercise its right to accept his tender notwithstanding the withdrawal or purported withdrawal, recover from him any additional expenses to which it may be put in having to call for tenders afresh or in the acceptance of any less favourable tender.

26. CEDING OF RIGHTS:

26.1 The contractor shall not cede, delegate or assign wholly or in part rights or obligations arising out of a contract nor may he enter into contracts in connection with such contracts without the written consent of Transnet Ltd. If a contractor should desire to cede, delegate or assign rights to obligations, or to enter into contracts he shall make application therefore to Transnet Ltd., and shall submit the names and addresses of the proposed contractor, and the contractor shall be responsible for insuring that such contractors as may be approved of in writing shall abide by all the terms of the contract in so far as those terms apply to them.

27. DUE FULFILMENT OF CONTRACT CONDITIONS:

- 27.1 If a tenderer after he has been notified of the acceptance of this tender, (i.e. after the contract has been concluded) fails to carry out the terms of the contract within the period specified by Transnet Ltd. in such case without prejudice to any other remedy which it may have, by notice to the successful tenderer cancel, as from a further date specified in such notice, the whole or any part of the contract and may proceed to accept any other tender, or if it is necessary to do so, call for tenders afresh and may recover from the defaulting contractor any additional expenses to which it has been put by reason for the calling of tenders afresh or by the acceptance of any less favourable tender, either from amongst those received in the first instance, or from amongst those received pursuant to the notice calling for tenders afresh.
- 27.2 The amount which may be recoverable from the tenderer or contractor in terms of these conditions, may without prejudice to any other legal remedies available to Transnet Ltd., be deducted in whole or in part from any moneys in the hands of Transnet Ltd. and due to the tenderer or contractor.

29. NOTIFICATION RE-AWARD OF BUSINESS:

29.1 In the case of tenders returnable to the Chairman of the Tender Board, Tenderers will be formally notified of the name of the successful tenderer as soon as possible after the closing date for receipt of the tender in question. 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BROAD BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT (BBBEE)

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it is strongly of the opinion that all South African Business Enterprises have an equal obligation to redress the imbalances of the past.

Transnet will therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will endeavour to do business with local business enterprises that possess a BBBEE "recognition level" of at least a level 5. Transnet urges Tenderers (large enterprises and QSE's - see below) to have themselves accredited by any one of the various Accreditation Agencies available, who do their BBBEE ratings in accordance with the latest Codes (i.e. those promulgated on 9 February 2007) and whose names appear on the present ABVA (Association of BEE Verification Agencies) – "List of Full Members" as displayed on the ABVA website (www.abva.co.za).

Although no agencies have, as yet, been accredited by SANAS (SA National Accreditation System), Transnet will, in the interim, accept rating certificates of tenderers who have been verified by any of the listed agencies.

EME's should provide documentary proof of annual turnover (i.e. audited financials) plus proof of Black ownership if Black ownership >50% or Black Women ownership >30% from the EME's Auditor/Accounting Officer.

In addition to the above, Tenderers who wish to enter into a Joint Venture or subcontract portions of the contract to BBBEE companies, must state in their tenders the percentage, of the total contract value that will be allocated to such BBBEE companies, should they be successful in being awarded any business.
