SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS FOR A 15-METER TOWER

1. SCOPE

This schedule covers the requirements of Transnet Freight Rail for the:

- 1.1. Manufacturing and supply of a 15-meter 4-legged lattice tower.
- 1.2. Manufacturing and supply of the installation kit complete with:
 - 1.2.1. Assembly bolt set
 - 1.2.2. Base plate
 - 1.2.3. Template
 - 1.2.4. Anchor bolts with cage set
 - 1.2.5. Lightning spike with down conductor
 - 1.2.6. Tower foundation earth kit
- 1.3. Delivery of all the tower and material to Saldanha.

2. TOWER DESCRIPTION AND TYPE

- 2.1. The tower height must be 15-meter above ground level.
- 2.2. The tower must be a 4-legged free standing lattice tower.
- 2.3. The tower with steel accessories must be galvanized.
- 2.4. The tower specifications are based on the Webb "15-meter 4-Leg Tube Lattice SS Tower (RDS Model)" and a tower with equal or better specifications must be quoted on.

3. TOWER STRENGTH AND LOADING REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1. The tower must be suitable for a Terrain Category 2 installation as per the SABS-0160 specification.
- 3.2. The tower must be designed for wind speeds up to 40 meters per second.
- 3.3. The tower must be designed for a mean return period of 50 years.
- 3.4. The tower must be able to accommodate a wind loading of 1 square meter at a height of 15 meters with a serviceability factor of 0.60.

4. APPLICABLE CODES OF PRACTICE

- 4.1. SABS 0160 – Design and loading standard
- 4.2. SABS 1431 Grade 300WA is the minimum requirement for the steel used for the tower.



1 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE]

Transnet fully endorses and supports the Government's Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Programme and it would therefore prefer to do business with local business enterprises who share these same values. Transnet will accordingly allow a "preference" to companies who provide a B-BBEE Verification Certificate. All procurement transactions will be evaluated accordingly.

1.1 B-BBEE Scorecard and Rating

As prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note the following:

- Proposals will be evaluated on price which will be allocated 80 points and preference which will be allocated 20 points, dependent on the value of the Services
- The 80/20 preference point system applies where the acquisition of the Services will be less than R1 000 000.00.
- If the 80/20 preference point system is stipulated and all Bids received exceed R1 000 000.00, the RFP will be cancelled

In compliance with the Government Gazette No. 34612, Notice No. 754 dated 23 September 20-1, as from 1 October 2011 valid B-BBEE Verification Certificates must be issued by:

- a) Verification Agencies accredited by the South African National Accreditation System [SANAS]; or
- b) Registered Auditors approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors [IRBA], in accordance with the approval granted by the Department of Trade and Industry.

Enterprises will be rated by such agencies based on the following:

- c) **Large Enterprises** [i.e. annual turnover greater than R35 million]:
 - Rating level based on all seven elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- d) **Qualifying Small Enterprises – QSE** [i.e. annual turnover between R5 million and R5 million]:
 - Rating based on any four of the elements of the B-BBEE scorecard
- e) **Exempted Micro Enterprises – EME** [i.e. annual turnover less than R5 million]:

In accordance with B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice [Statement 000, Section 4], any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R 5 million or less qualifies as an EME.

- Automatic rating of B-BBEE Level 4 irrespective of race or ownership
 - Black ownership greater than 50% or Black Women ownership greater than 50% automatically qualify as B-BBEE Level 3
- Sufficient evidence to qualify as an EME would be a certificate (which may be in the form of a letter) from an auditor or accounting officer or a certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS. The certificate must confirm the company's turnover, black ownership / black female ownership and B-BBEE status level.



Respondents are required to furnish proof of the above to Transnet. [i.e. a detailed scorecard as stipulated above in respect of Large Enterprises and QSEs, or a certificate in respect of EMEs].

Transnet will accordingly allocate a maximum of **20 [twenty] points** in accordance with the **80/20** preference point system prescribed in the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations to the Respondent's final score based on an entity's B-BBEE scorecard rating.

N.B. Failure to submit a B-BBEE certificate, which is valid as at the Closing Date of this RFP, will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

2 Evaluation Criteria

Transnet will utilise the following criteria in choosing a Supplier/Service Provider:-

- Weighted evaluation based on 80/20 preference point system:

Transnet will utilise the following formula in its evaluation of Price:

$$\bullet \text{ PS} = 80 \left(\frac{P_t - P_{min}}{P_t - P_{max}} \right)$$

Where:

P_s = Score for the Bid under consideration
 P_t = Price of Bid under consideration
 P_{min} = Price of lowest acceptable Bid

- B-BBEE status of company

Preference points will be awarded to a bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:
