Transnet SOC Limited trading as Transnet Freight Rail invites tenders **For The Internal And External Repairs To Diesel Storage Tank B At The Nelspruit Diesel Locomotive Depot.**

Tenderers should have a contractor grading of **1ME PE** or **2ME** or higher. Preferences are offered to tenderers who are in possession of a valid SANAS or IRBA B-BBEE accreditation certificate.

Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or capable of being so prior to evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to **1ME PE** or **2ME** or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, for a **1ME PE** or **2ME** or higher class of construction work, are legible to have their tenders evaluated.

Tender documents may be obtained on and after Tuesday, **03**rd – **11**th **January 2017** from the Transnet Freight Rail, Tender Advice Centre, Ground floor, Nzasm building, c/o Paul Kruger and Minnaar streets, Pretoria during the office hours 09h00 to 15h00, where they can be examined.
