2 Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [B-BBEE]

Note: Failure to submit a valid and original B-BBEE certificate or a certified copy thereof at the Closing Date of this RFQ will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

2.1 B-BBEE Improvement Plan Transnet encourages its Suppliers/Service Providers to constantly strive to improve their B-BBEE rating. Whereas Respondents will be allocated points in terms of a preference point system based on its B-BBEE scorecard to be assessed as detailed in paragraph 2.1 above, in addition to such scoring, Transnet also requests that Respondents submit a B-BBEE improvement plan. Respondents are therefore requested to indicate the extent to which the extent to which they will maintain or improve their B-BBEE status over the contract period. SPECIFICATIONS 2015/2017 – GLENCOE- DUNDEE

GLENCOE A: 34 500 m2 ECX0198U

- All Transnet land above the Railway line from Biggar Street through to Alice Street. This includes the embankments, the parking area, around the residential houses, around the old Trantel Bdg, and the relay room area.
- This is inclusive of the roadsides along the gravel road known as Alice Street 7up to the 3-line level crossing (Mast pole No 119/17). Also inclusive of the triangle between the tracks M/P No 119/17 (crossing opposite c/o Alice and Francis Streets).
- From Biggar Street town entrance to the first bridge, right side of the unnamed tarred Railway through to the Emily Street Crossing (Railway Road/Louisa Street junction corner).
- Cut all vegetation within Spoornet boundaries and Karel Landman Street cut alongside concrete wall to Sanlam Plein Street. Take a straight line from Karel Land man Street Sanlam Plein and cut in a line through to tarred Railway Road at Loco. Weed Spraying on or tarred areas of verges and gutters. Eradication of all Noxious Weeds

Payment will be effected within thirty (30) days of end of month in which the invoice is presented, and after inspection has been completed to the satisfaction of Transnet Representative.

It is the contractor's responsibility to maintain the relevant areas as per specs through out the year.

With immediate effect all contractors working on or near the rail track must wear reflective clothing. A contractor who is required to cross the track at any time during the duration of his contract must be protected by flagmen with a white flag 600m on either side of the work site, warning trains of people working on the track. In addition hard hats with visors and safety footwear are necessary at all times.

If this is not adhered to Transnet Inspectors can order the workers off the site.

A PCO certified operator will be required to be present together with their certificate of registration at all sites where a team is working
