BACKGROUND:

Scope of work

Transnet Freight Rail would like to invite companies specialising in the design and manufacture of billboards to submit quotations for the job scope as listed below. *Note that all specifications will be the property of Transnet Freight Rail upon completion.*

REQUIREMENTS

The supplier will be required to:

1. Printing and Installation of new graphics

Recreate form existing design, print and install /erect the advert on the existing 10 structures. Printing needs to be of high quality 720dpi print resolution onto 550gsm Black White PVC flex face banner with re-enforced welded edges and 50mm pocket all round measuring 3x6m single sided.

2. Logistics

The supplier will be responsible for the transportation and logistics from their place of manufacture to the designated site. In most instances these sites are difficult to reach points along the rail line and are not on roads or formal arterials.

3. Installation

The supplier will be responsible the installation of graphics for the each structure at site in accordance with the specifications and technical drawings. It will be the responsibility of the supplier to guarantee the installation for 24 months minimum and adherence to this must be taken into consideration.

4. Safety certification

As part of TFR's safety regulations, all suppliers and their staff will be required to undergo an internal safety program before commencing work at site.

5. Maintenance

This campaign is scheduled for a period of 24 months over which time it will be the responsibility of the supplier to routinely inspect, repair and maintain the structure to its original condition.

"functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;

"non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;

"person" includes reference to a juristic person;

"rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes an applicable taxes and excise duties;

"subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;

"total revenue" bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;

"trust" means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and

"trustee" means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

The Bidder obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RFP will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another bidder.

Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.

Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.

In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.

However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.

Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.



POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

In terms of Regulation 5(2) and 6(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to must be prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.

Bidders other than EMEs must symmetheir original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.

A trust, consortium or joint yeature will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.

A trust, consortium or joint centure will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.

Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.

A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.

A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
