- 1.2 Transnet reserves the right to require of a Bidder, either before a Bid is adjudicated or at any time substructly, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by Transnet.

2 GENERAL DEFINITIONS

- 2.6 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of

- combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.7 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by Transnet;
- 2.8 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of Fo [five] million or less as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R10 [ten] million or less as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Given Vent Gazette No. 36928;
- 2.9 **"firm price"** means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the mange, imposition, or abolition of customs and excise duty and any other cuty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering loss of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.10 **"functionality"** means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, on a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.11 "non-irm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.12 **person** includes reference to a juristic person;
- means any enterprise with an annual total revenue between R5 [five] million and R35 [thirty five] million as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of between R10 [ten] million and R50 [fifty] million as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928
- 2.14 "rand value" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.15 "subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.16 "total revenue" bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;

- 4.2 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as concemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Arditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approvan for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Let el Certificates.
- 4.3 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Sazette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual back confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership.

- 4.5 The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928].
