

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# 1. PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK FOR TANK REPAIRS

The following summarizes Tank Repairs scope of work at Sasolburg Depot

# 1.1 TANK BOTTOM:

- 1.1.1 Striker plate was not welded right round; replace striker plate with a 300X300 plate welded right round and having rounded corners. Perform NDT and issue report.
- 1.1.2. About 1 500 mm of corrosion and pitting noted on shell to bottom weld on southern and eastern side. Repair corrosion and pitting on shell to bottom weld by grinding and re-welding on the southern and eastern side. Refer to the below photos.





1.1.3 The water drain pipe bracket is keited directly on the sump. Replace water drain pipe bracket welded directly on the floor with bracket welded on pads.

# 1.2 NOZZLES AND APPURITUANCES:

- 1.2.1 Design and Install a diffuser on the inlet nozzle.
- 1.2.2 Grind and re-weld the internal weld on inlet nozzle and perform NDT.
- 1.2.3 Grind and re-weld internal weld on blanked nozzle and perform NDT.
- 1.2.4. Install all welded thermal relief system with a PRV across inlet/outlet valve as per the attached top drawing.
- 1.2.5. Repair corrosion and paint roof ATG nozzle and pipe according to Transnet specification (Plascon Silver paint).
- 1.2.6. Repair corrosion and paint roof man way according to Transnet specification.
- 1.2.7. Replace broken earth wire.
- 1.2.8. Clean and grease tell-tale holes.
- 1.2.9. Drainage and emptying of the pipelines to allow new connection.1.2.10. Design, Supply and Install a dedicated 4" tank outlet pipeline with pipe supports and a new 4" tank outlet ball lalve, with thermal bypass system on the existing tank nozzle and install a spade on the valve. The pipeline should be installed up to just outside the tank fund wall with a blank flange. To allow future upgrade to continue with the pipeline right to the new pumps house.
- 1.2.11. Pressure testing of the new line as per the API requirements 1.2.12. Replace old gaskets and bolts with new ones and service valve before returning tank to service.

# 1.3 Tank Roof:

- 1.3.1. Paint roof according to 1 snet specification (Plascon Silver paint).
- 1.3.2. Replace broken mosh wire on roof vent.

## 2. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS

- All pipeline flanges must be fitted with the spiral wound gaskets as per the attached specification
- Issue Certificate for all new valves
- The Thermal relief valves to be a bailey type, set at 350 Kpa and valve certificate is required.
- For all new welds a non-destructive testing must be performed and report must be issued to the client prior commissioning of the tank.
- Quality data pack with all the necessary required information i.e. Welding procedure, welders qualifications etc.
- Safety files with all the necessary required information i.e Method statement, risk assessment, medicals, legal appointments etc.
- Transnet Safety compliance and full FPE
- Equipment warranty (inlet and outlet valves)
- All Repairs must be done as per the SPI 653 code





Transnet reserves the right to require of a Bidder, either before a Bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by Transnet.
