1. SCOPE OF WORK AND SUMMARY OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR INTERNAL TANK CLEANING WORKS AT ERMELO DEPOT PREPARED BY: MR THABO NKOANE

1.1 <u>Internal & external tank cleaning and varec gauge calibration on tank No. 1</u>

The diesel storage tank has not been cleaned over 5 years and it is evident that there is debris, algae deposit at the bottom of the tank. Petro chemical standards that fuel storage tanks should be routine cleaned every 5 years. This tank No 1 is long overdue for the clean-up. The varec level gauge is also out of calibration and it requires repairs then calibrated during this period of tank cleaning exercise. The shell thickness test should be performed to determine the material corrosion rate. This entire works should be performed under the guidance of API and SANS standard to ensure statutory compliance.

2. Proposed Scope of Works for internal cleaning:

- 2.1 Pump product from TK1 to TK2, tanks should be emptied to the base minimum.
- 2.2 Isolate all piping, drainage system and values connecting to the Tank, if valves are to be closed then they are to be protected against inadvertent operation by the use of pneumatic or electric isolation of the actuator, and in case of manual valves the hand wheels are to be removed, to ensure isolation.
- 2.3 Open all manholes to vent the tank 24hrs before start of work.
- 2.4 All tank mounted electrical equipment (except earthing and bonding cables) is to be isolated at the distribution system. Tank cathodic protection systems shall be disconnected 24 hours before any work is to commence to allow depolarization to take place.
- 2.5 Perform gas testing gas testing prior to an work taking place and permit and safety plan required.
- 2.6 Suck sludge deposit inside the tank via super sucker tanker and clean inner walls then dispose sludge in the dedicated disposal site in accordance with hazardous disposal requirements and obtain disposable certificate for TFD.
- 2.7 Clean tank floors and walls then san blast then coat the internal with specific coating pigments including all nozzles.
- 2.8 Repair the Varec gauge then calibrate it and issue TFD with a certificate.

- 3.1 The Bidder obtaining the bi hest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RFP vill e awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another bidder.
- 3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.
- 3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.
- 3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.

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3.6 Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.



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4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

4.1 In terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 4.2 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- 4.3 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gozette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less and the entity's Level of Black owner hip.
- 4.4 In terms of the 2007 version or the Codes of Good Practice, Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B RBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS
- 4.5 In terms of the Revised coder of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928, Bidders who qualify as QSEs are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R50 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership. Large enterprises must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.6 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.7 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 4.8 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates

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in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.

- 4.9 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- 4.10 A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- Bidders are to note that in terms of paragraph 2.6 of Statement 000 of the Revised Codes of Good 4.11 Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928, any representation made by an entity about its B-BBEF ampliance must be supported by suitable evidence or documentation. As such, Transnet receives the right to request such evidence or documentation from Bidders in order to verify any B-BBEF recognition claimed.
