



5 BROAD-BASED BLACK ECONOMIC EMPOWEMENT AND SOCIO-ECONOMIC OBLIGATIONS

As described in more detail in the attached BBBEE Claim Form and as prescribed in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA), Act 5 of 2000 and its Regulations, Respondents are to note that Transnet will allow a "prescrence" to companies who provide a valid B-BBEE Verification Certificate.

The value of this bid is estimated to exceed R1 000 000 (all applicable taxes included); and therefore the **90/10** system shall be applicable.

Respondents are required to complete Section 7 [the B-BBEE Preference Point Claim Form] and submit it together with proof of their B-BBEE Status as stipulated in the Claim Form in order to obtain preference points for their B-BBEE Status.

Note: Failure to submit a valid and original B-BBEE certificate or a certified copy thereof at the Closing Date of this RFP will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

5.1 B-BBEE Joint Ventures or Consortiums

Respondents who would wish to respond to this RFP as a Joint Venture [JV] or consortium with B-BBEE entities, must state their intention to do so in their RFP submission. Such Respondents must also submit a signed JV or consortium agreement between the parties clearly stating the percentage [%] split of business and the associated responsibilities of each party. If such a JV or consortium agreement is unavailable, the partners must submit confirmation in writing of their intention to enter into a JV or consortium agreement should they be awarded business by Transnet through this RFP process. This written confirmation must clearly indicate the percentage [%] split

of business and the responsibilities of each party. In such cases, award of business will only take place once a signed copy of a JV or consortium agreement is submitted to Transnet.

Respondents are to note the requirements for B-BBEE compliance of JVs or consortiums as required by Section 7 [the B-BBEE Preference Point Claim Form] and submit it together with proof of their B-BBEE Status as stipulated in the Claim Form in order to obtain preference points for their B-BBEE status.

Note: Failure to submit a valid and original B-BBEE certificate for the JV or a certified copy thereof at the Closing Date of this RFP will result in a score of zero being allocated for B-BBEE.

5.2 Subcontracting

Transnet fully endorses Government's transformation and empowerment objectives and when contemplating subcontracting Respondents are requested to give preference to companies which are Black Owned, Black Women Owned, Black Youth Owned, owned by Black People with Disabilities, EMEs and QSEs including any companies designated as B-BBEE Facilitators¹.

If contemplating subcontracting, please note that a Respondent will not be awarded points for B-BBEE if it is indicated in its Proposal that such Respondent intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five percent] of the value of the contract to an entity/entities that do not qualify for at least the same points that the Respondent qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME with the capability to execute the contract.

A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five percent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.

In terms of Section 7 of this RFP [the B-BBEE Preference Point Claim Form] Respondents are required to indicate the percentage of the contract that will be sub-contracted as well as the B-BBEE status of the sub-contractor/s.

5.3 **B-BBEE Improvement Plan**

Transnet encourages its Service Providers to constantly stave to improve their B-BBEE rating. Whereas Respondents will be allocated points in terms of a preference point system based on its B-BBEE scorecard to be assessed as detailed in paragraph 5.1 above, in addition to such scoring, Transnet also requests that Respondents submit a B-BBEE improvement plan. Respondents are therefore requested to indicate the extent to which they will maintain or improve their B-BBEE status over the contract period.

Respondents are requested to submit their B-BBEE Improvement Plan as an additional document with their Proposals by completion of Annexure A appended hereto. [Refer to Section 8 and Annexure A for further instructions]

Note: Should a JV be envisaged the principal respondent is required to submit the required responses as indicated above.

The commitments made by the successful Respondents will be incorporated as a term of the contract and monitored for compliance.

Section 2: BACKGROUND, OVERVIEW AND SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS

1 **BACKGROUND**

This agreement covers for the provision of waste bins and the removal of waste at various depots in Polokwane, Modimolle, Mokopane, Makhado, Musina, Tzaneen, Mookgophong, Bela-Bela and Piennaarsriver for a period of 36 months, as decided by Transnet.

The essence of the agreement is that Transnet Freight Rail requires that the services that are to be rendered, ensure clean and neat environment.

2 **SCOPE OF REQUIREMENTS**

- 2.1.1 The monthly volume of waste/refuse to be removed amounts ±18m³ per month for the Station Building Polokwane and to be emptied three times a month and $\pm 6 \text{m}^3$ per site for all other sites and has to be emptied only once a month.
- 2.1.2 Where the Skip bins has to be emptied three times a month, it has to be done normally in the beginning, middle and at the end of each month or only to be emptied once a month, it has to be emptied at the end of each month.
- 2.1.3 If the Skip bin is full before the time that it must be emptied as agreed on, the successful respondent will be notified telephonically and it must then be empty within 36 hours.
- 2.1.4 Skip bins to be emptied only from Monday to Friday between 07h30 and 16h00 and a Transnet representative of the specific site has to sign the delivery note stating that the Skip bins has been emptied.

 2.1.5 When the Skip bins have been emptied, the area must be cleared not to refuse should be lying around. All the waste/refuse falling from the Skip bins / vehicle during the empting, the strucessful respondent shall clean the area.
- 2.1.6 The Skip bins must be placed at a place / area as indicated by TEP representative at the applicable site / depot.
- 2.1.7 The contract shall be awarded for a period of 36 month, and vill be stipulated in the Letter of Acceptance.
- 2.1.8 No penalties will apply to this contract, but no pay nent will be made without the delivery note, signed by a TFR representative as proof that the Skip bins for that six has been empty for that month.

4.2 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification

- Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- 4.3 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership.
- 4.4 In terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice, Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928]. The Revised Codes will replace the Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice issued on 9 February 2007. The Revised Codes provide for a transitional period ending 30 April 2015. During the transitional period, companies may elect to be measured in terms of the Revised Codes or the 2007 version of the Codes. Companies which are governed by Sector-specific Codes will be measured in terms of those Sector Codes.
- 4.6 As such, Transnet will accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes. Transnet will also continue to accept B-BBEE certificates issued in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes provided it was issued before 1 May 2015. Thereafter, Transpet will only accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes.
- In terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice, Bidders who quality is QSEs must comply with all 4.7 the elements of B-BBEE for the purposes of measurement. QSE that are at least 51% or 100% Black owned are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit over annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R50 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership. Large enterprises must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating being a-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accedited by SANAS.
- 4.8 A trust, consortium or joint venture will quality for joints for its B-BBEE status level as a legal
- entity, provided that the entity submits its 8-BBEE status level certificate.

 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every 4.9 separate bid.
- Tertiary institutions and public entitles will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level 4.10 certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends ubcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of 4.11 the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Ridor qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and a pility of execute the subcontract.
- 4.12 A person a video a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level had the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- Bidders are to note that in terms of paragraph 2.6 of Statement 000 of the Revised Codes of Good 4.13 Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928, any representation made by an entity about its B-BBEE compliance must be supported by suitable evidence or documentation. As such, Transnet reserves the right to request such evidence or documentation from Bidders in order to verify any B-BBEE recognition claimed.




