<u>Description: SITE ASSESSMENT OF THE POROPOSED REMEDIATION AT TFR</u>
CONTAMINATED FUELLING SITES

TENDER SPECIFICATIONS

THE APPOINTMENT OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PLACTITIONER/S TO CONDUCT SITE ASSESSMENTS FOR THE PROPOSED REMEDIATION AT TRANSNET FREIGHT RAIL CONTAMINATED FUELLING SITES.

1. PURPOSE OF THE CONTRACT

- 1.1 The purpose of the contract is to arrange for the provision of an independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner/s to undertake site Assessments required in terms of Part 8 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act. 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008) (Waste Act).
- 1.2 The incumbent Environmental Assessment practiconer/s will be required to comply with the specific requirements of the above-mentioned Act on behalf of Transnet Freight Rail by compiling and submitting to TFR the Phas 2. Site Assessment Reports to address the extent of site pollution at fuelling sites environmental impacts of the future clean-up proposal, identification and assessment of the best available clean-up techniques not exceeding excessive costs (BETNEEC). The assessment process will determine the extent of contamination in terms of liepth and dimensions quantify contaminated soil in terms of tons and cubic meters and specify the amount of soil that is supposed to be remediated or excavated for remodal.
- 1.3 Successful conclusion of the Site Assessments process will enable Transnet Freight Rail to initiate the removation of contaminated land at fuelling sites as is currently required in terms of Part 8 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act 59 of 2008).

2. AC GROUND

- 2.1 There have been several spillages occurring at TFR fuelling sites in bulk storage tank areas due faulty meter gauges and ageing fuelling infrastructure among other things, which is historic in nature. As a result, the diesel spilled over time and resulted in soil contamination.
- 2.2 In response to the contamination, Transnet Freight Rail commissioned Engineering firm to conduct Phase 1: Site Assessments countrywide on priority fuelling sites. The said assessments did not include Intrusive Assessments but rather focussed on Visual Assessments of the sites, hence the process to commission Phase 2 Assessments of specified sites.
- 2.3 Before remediation of hydrocarbon pollution can commence TFR will have to comply with the requirements of Part 8 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act 59 of 2008).



3. SCOPE OF WORK

- 3.1 This contract covers the responsibilities and services rendered by the Assessment Practitioner to undertaking the requisite degree of study to assess the nature and extent of contamination at TFR fuelling sites in line with the requirements of Part 8 of the National Environment Management Act, 2008 as effected on 2 May 2013.
- 3.2 The service provider shall as part of the Site Assessments commission a risk assessment study detailing the depth of contamination through scientific methods and also outline the best methodology for remediation per individual sites.
- 3.3 The assessment will be aimed at gathering all issues relating to the proposal and in detail addressing them within individual Site Assessment Reports.
- 3.4 As per the requirements of S37 (b) of the Waste Act, the site as a sament report must at least contain information on whether—
 - 3.4.1 The contamination has already impacted on lealth or the environment;
 - 3.4.2 The substances present in or on the land are toxic, persistent or bioaccumulative or are present in a ge quantities or high concentrations or occur in c ombinations; there are exposive pathways available to the substances;
 - 3.4.3 The use or proposed use of the land and adjoining land increases or is likely to increase the risk to health the environment:
 - 3.4.4 The substances have migrated or are likely to migrate from the land;
 - 3.4.5 The acceptable exposure for human and environmental receptors in that environment have been exceeded;
 - 3.4.6 And applicable standards have been exceeded; and
 - .4.7 harea should be remediated or any other measures should be taken to manage or neutralise the risk.
- 3.5 Compile and submit Site Assessment Reports and associated documentation to Transnet Freight Rail and to the competent authorities as outlined in the Waste Act.
- 3.6 The site assessment reports shall in addition contain detailed investigations into the following:
 - Intrusive Site Characterisation and Assessment;
 - Conceptual Site Model;
 - Risk Assessment; and
 - Status of Contamination Risk.
 - Calculation and GIS Mapping of the extent of contamination per site.
 - Quantification of contamination in cubic meters and tons.

4.2 Initiation of an assessment process to produce reports of sufficient details contained therein, so as to meet the minimum requirements of Part 8 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008. Within a period of six (6) months effective from date of appointment.



4.3 In addition to individual Site Assessment Reports, the contractor shall produce separate Risk Assessment Reports detailing the depth of contamination and outlining the appropriate methodology for rehabilitation.

5. DURATION OF THE CONTRACT

5.1 The contract will run for a maximum period of nine(9) months, thereafter a report is required within 10 days upon completion of the Client's comment period.

6. TERMINATION OF CONTRACT

- 6.1 Transnet shall have the right to terminate the above contract on grounds of non-performance, or unsatisfactory performance on the part of the service provider in the execution of this project.
- 6.2 Termination shall take place only after thorough consideration and due notification of grounds being provided by the Environmental Manager in writing with a notice period of five (5) working days.
- 6.3 The successful Service Provider will be required to enter into a performance contract with Transnet Freight Rail.

7. INSTRUCTION TO THE APPOINTED CONTRACTOR

- 7.1 The prospective service provider must provide separate quotes for individual groups as in 5.1.
- 7.2 The contractor and his team hust undergo induction training before starting on site given by Transnet Freight Rail.

8. QUALIFICATION AND RESOURCES OF THE POTENTIAL SERVICE PROVIDERS

- 8.1 The contrast envisaged under this tender will be awarded to an Environmental Assessment Practioner/s who has knowledge in the field of environmental assessment, pollution assess ent and remediation of contaminated land, and applicable references for the same tork completed.
- s the undertaking of the Site Assessments will be country-wide in nature, the tenderers shall leclare own resources to be utilised and deployment strategy country-wide, should the prospective service provider opt to tender for sites country-wide.
- 8.3 Given the extensive nature of the work required under this contract, prospective service providers shall opt to tender for selected sites or for entire sites as in 5.1 above.
- 8.4 Incumbent service provider/s shall attach full particulars of their qualifications, quoting specific references if any, and contact numbers. Transnet shall have the right to make contact with referenced clients to verify the nature and quality of the service provided.
- 8.5 Given the responsible nature of the work envisaged under this contract, Transnet reserves the right to award the tender to Environmental Assessment Practitioner/s of choice, with due regard for a favourable balance between the cost of services, resources available and knowledge in the assessment of pollution, remediation of contaminated land and quantity surveying field.
