No RFQ/tender fee is applicable and will be issued "FREE OF CHARGE" to all respondents.

A compulsory information briefing session will be conducted in 05 August 2016. Thereafter a compulsory site visit will also follow to the site at the long darshalling Yard in Port Elizabeth. Attendance is compulsory and <u>failure to attend</u> will disqualify submissions from evaluation.

10 SPECIFICATION/SCOPE OF WORK

Scope of work:

Transnet Freight Rail requires the provision of an efficient **F**(**F** cleaning and clearing service to their site situated at Coega Marshalling Yard in Port Elizabeth for a period of 24 months. The successful service provider will have to supply the material, labout transport and consumables of any description, which may be necessary for the proper completion of the contract work, in accordance with the specifications as follows:

• Site to be serviced every 2nd month over a period of 24 months = 12 services

Site Information

The site consists of the following area

Cogga Marshalling Yard erf no CSX 1011E = 400 000 m²

Note: Services vin be required as follows but is subjected to changes:

PARTICULAR SPECIFICATION

CLEANING AND CLEARING:

The works include the following:

- All bushes and trees up to 75mm diameter to be cut off as close to 100mm above ground level as possible.
- All other grass and overgrowth to be cut to a height of not more than 80mm above ground level.
- All trees/shrubs and branches to be trimmed 2m above ground level
- All trimming around flowerbeds, paths, edges and around all structures i.e. buildings and fences.
- The verge on either side of the road must be trimmed 1meter wide at a height of 30mm
- All grass and overgrowth on the pavements and curbing on the side of the roads must be cut

- The site shall be cleaned of all litter such as paper, rubble, and tins, plastic and other debris
- All material, rubbish, litter and rubble must be removed from site and transported and dumped at an approved municipality dumpsite

INCOMPETENT EMPLOYEES

Any person employed by the contractor on the Works, who is, in the opinion of the Project Manager incompetent, or who may act in such an improper manner, may be discharge from the works by the Project Manager. Such a person shall not again be employed on the works without the permission of the Project Manager.

DRAWINGS:

Site plan of site is attached as annexure D.

TIME TO COMPLETE THE WORK

- The contractor shall indicate herein the duration he requires to lete the work per service to the site, but the period shall be preferred to be not be longer than 15 (fifteen) working days.
- The contractor shall be required to complete the work se vice in this period, as given. This period excludes weekends, public holidays and statutory holiday periods.
- Failing completion of the work within the period as stipulated above or with any period offered by the contenders and accepted by Transnet, the contractor shall pay to Transnet as penalty the sum of R 500.00 (five hundred rand) for every day or part thereof during which the works remain incomplete.

RISK ASSESSMENT:

- Employees of contractor to wear safety vest at all times on the site. #
- Employees of contractor to wear safety foot protection on the site. #
- Employees of contractor to wear eye and ear protection when working with weed cutters # and chainsaws. No opin fires are allowed on the site.

- The contractor shall provide full time supervisor on the site.

- A safety induction will be conducted with the successful bidder by TFR before any # contract work can commence.

SITE RECORDS:

Site Diary

The Contractor shall provide a diary, in triplicate to record all day-to-day incidents that could occur during the contract period. This includes weather, name & number of workers on the site, material that has been delivered, material that has been loaded and disposed of, incidences that have occurred, what work is to be done on that day, etc.

Program & Planning of the work

The contractor shall provide to the manager a detail plan of how he intends to do the work and this plan must be to the requirements of the operation of Transnet freight rail with minor disruptions as no delays must be allowed in this regard.

The program must be agreed to (in the site instruction book) before any work will be allowed to commence. The program may be in a form of a pert (bar) chart and will be used as a guide to measure progress of the work.

ACCESS TO SITE

The areas are restricted and the contractor must ensure he complies with the regulations of Transnet freight rail in every way. Contractor and/or any sub-contractors shall be required to apply for permission to enter the restricted area in writing. A list of workmen shall be given to the Project Manager to arrange for the necessary permits. 48 Hours minimum notice is necessary for the processing these permits. This includes changes to staff during the contract period.

• MATERIALS FOUND ON SITE

The Contractor shall not use on the works any materials found on the site without the prior written consent of the manager. No material that is lying on the site (other than that from this contract) or on Transnet freight rail's property may be removed (even if deemed as scrap) by the contractor.

No scrap or any material of value may be removed from the site without written authority of the Project Manager.

• CLEARING OF SITE

The Contractor shall provide for cleaning up and sorting all rubbish and debris of whatever kind throughout the duration of the contract. Upon completion the Contractor shall char away and remove all rubbish, unused material, plant and debris and leave the site and the whole of the works clean and tidy to the satisfaction of the Project Manager.

ESCALATION

This contract does not make provision for compensation in respect of increased costs. The contenders must allow in his fixed price for any increased costs, which he may encounter during the contract period or such extended period as agreed upon by both parties.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS AND INSURANCE



This preference form contains general information and serves as a claim for preference points for Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment [**B-BBEE**] Status Level of Contribution.

1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 A total of 20 preference points shall be awarded for B-BBEE Status Level of Contribution.
- 1.2 Failure on the part of a Bidder to fill in and/or to sign this form and submit a B-BBEE Verification Certificate from a Verification Agency accredited by the South African Accreditation System [SANAS] or a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors [IRBA] or an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the Close Corporation (CCA) together with the bid will be interpreted to mean that preference points for B-BBEE status level of Contribution are not claimed.
- 1.3 Transnet reserves the right to require of a Bidder, either before a Bid is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by Transnet.

2. GENERAL DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 "all applicable taxes" include 'alu-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;
- 2.2 **"B-BBEE"** means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Fool mic Empowerment Act;
- 2.3 "B-BBEE status or contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its vera performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;
- 2.4 **"Bid"** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by Transnet for the provision of goods, works or services;
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 [Act No. 53 of 2003];
- 2.6 **"comparative price"** means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can utilised have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by Transnet;

- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 [five] million or less as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R10 [ten] million or less as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928;
- 2.10 "firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs and excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;
- 2.11 **"functionality"** means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes reference to a juristic person;
- 2.14 "QSE" means any enterprise with an annual total reverue between R5 [five] million and R35 [thirty five] million as per the 2007 version of the B RBEE Lodes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of between R10 [ten] million and R50 [fifty] million as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928
- 2.15 "**rand value**" means the total stimute value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.16 "subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.17 **"total reven e"** wars the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;
- 2.18 **"trust"** means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and
- 2.19 **"trustee"** means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 3.1 The Bidder obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RFP will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another bidder.
- 3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.
- 3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.

- 3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

4.1 In terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 4.2 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in tenns of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Degistered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IREAS approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Leve Certificates.
- 4.3 Bidders with qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership.
- In terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice, Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928]. The Revised Codes will replace the Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice issued on 9 February 2007. The Revised Codes provide for a transitional period ending 30 April 2015. During the transitional period, companies may elect to be measured in terms of the Revised Codes or the 2007 version of the Codes. Companies which are governed by Sector-specific Codes will be measured in terms of those Sector Codes.

- 4.6 As such, Transnet will accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes. Transnet will also continue to accept B-BBEE certificates issued in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes provided it was issued before 1 May 2015. Thereafter, Transnet will only accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes.
- In terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice, Bidders who qualify as QSEs must comply with all the elements of B-BBEE for the purposes of measurement. QSEs that are at least 51% or 100% Black owned are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R50 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership. Large enterprises must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.8 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.9 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE corecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 4.10 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required a subplit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.11 A person will not be awarded points for BIBBEE states level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that their not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- A person awarded a contract hay not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
