SPECIFICATIONS, SCOPE AND SPECIAL CONDITIONS

1.0 SCOPE

1.1. This project specification covers the requirements for the flushing and replacement of oil in 3 oil circuit breakers installed at Ferum Track Feeder Stations along the Sishen-Saldanha railway line. Ferum 5 backion is situated in Kathu. Carry out replacement of all contact fingers, moving tips and orcing rings. This work must be done during the annual shutdown period of 15 September 2015 until 24 September 2015. Tests must be performed as stipulated in clause 4.4.

2.0 SPECIFICATIONS AND STANDARDS

The following publications (latest edition) are referred to herein and shall apply:

2.1 Transnet Freight Rail: **GI.012 Supervision and maintenance of insulating oils in electrical equipment.**

Transnet will supply the clean (new) oil and the empty drums for the dirty oil.

- 2.2 South African National Standards:
 - SANS 555- Mineral insulating oil for circuit breakers.
- 2.3 Should conflicting requirements exist between this specification and referenced specifications, the requirements of this specification shall apply.

3.0 EQUIPMENT

Seven traction feeder stations feed into the Transnet Freight Rail overhead traction equipment at 50kV 40MVA via 2 single-phase feeders from Eskom. Five of these feeders are protected by one 88kV Delle-Alsthom (type HPGE 10-14C) oil circuit breaker each. A similar oil circuit breaker is also used as a bus-coupler. Transnet Freight Rail requires that the oil circuit breakers Ferrum (Kathu/Sishen) Erts be maintained as per this specification. The oil and the empty drums for the oil will be provided by Transnet Freight Rail.

4.0 DESCRIPTION OF WORK

The following paragraphs stipulate the specific requirements of work to be performed by the Contractor.

4.1 INSPECTION OF OIL CIRCUIT BREAKER (OCB'S)

This process requires that the existing oil in the OCP be trained. The breaker must be in the open position with closing spring discharged. Remove and service top lid. The arching chamber and the bottom insulation chamber must be drained separately but simultaneously. It takes a while for oil to drain completely. A small pump can be used to draw out the oil but in this scenario the arching chamber must be done first. Once this is empty, drain the bottom compartment. Both top and bottom taps remain open during this places. Remove fix contact and tabulator assembly, clean and inspect for wear or damage and report. Remove gauge glass and gaskets and replace.

4.2 FLUSHING OF OIL CIRCUIT BREAKERS

- 4.2.1 Flush the arching chamber with clean oil until the oil running out through the pipe is clean. This can be puriped out while flushing. (The bottom drain valve can remain open during this process). Clean of can low be pumped in through the bottom tap and then sucked out the bottom tap again this is for flushing the bottom chamber. Once both drainpipes show clean oil draining out, both taps can be closed and pipes removed. Oil should be filled from the top. First the arching chamber and then through the special opening connected to the bottom chamber. This must be done by using a funnel and waiting till the both chambers even out.
- 4.2.2 Replace fix contact and turbulator assembly.

4.3 REPLACEMENT OF OIL CIRCUIT BREAKER OIL

- 4.3.1 After the flushing process is completed the OCB can be re-filled with new suitable mineral insulating oil. Approximately 80 litres. Breaker can be filled from the bottom tap but you risk overfilling before the two compartments level out. Some experience is required here. **Do not operate the breaker while breaker has no oil in bottom chamber.**
- 4.3.2 Replace top lid.

4.3.3 Mechanism

Cleaning and Lubrication

- o Clean the mechanism box with white spirit or Kerosene, and wiped with a clean and dry cloth.
- SAE 90 oil must used to lubricate chains and sprockets.
- o Pins and rollers, lever hinges, tie-rods and return spring should be lubricated with silicone oil.

Inspection

- Latches for proper operation
- Indicating switches for proper operation
- o Electric connections for tightness
- Condition of motor commutator and brushes in mechanism BLPM (Electrical motor)
- Conditions of cover seal and operation of heating system
- Closing electromagnet (E) voltages coil with tension
- Tripping electromagnet (D) current coil with tension
- Transmission chain of closing sprin
- Condition of the bell crank

4.4 TESTS

- 4.4.1 The new oil put be certified as per engineering instruction GI.012 clause 14.1.1 14.1.4 and SANS 555.
- 4.4.2 Measure contact resistance (Ductor test < 75 milli ohm) and report. This test must be performed before and after oil flushing.
- 4.4.3 Speed tests (contacts open and contacts close) must be performed after oil flushing.

5.0 GUARANTEE

- 5.1 All work, oil and material shall be guaranteed for a period of twelve calendar months after date of final acceptance of the work.
- 5.2 The Contractor shall make good any defects, due to inferior material, oil or workmanship, which may arise during this period within 24 hours after notification.
- 5.3 Should the Contractor fail to comply with the requirements stipulated in clause 5.2 Transnet Freight Rail shall be entitled to undertake the necessary repair work or effect replacement of defective apparatus or materials.

5.4 The Contractor shall then reimburse Transnet Freight Rail the total cost of such repair or replacement, including labour costs incurred.

6.0 SERVICES AND RESPONSIBILITIES FOR WORK

- 6.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for the transport of all equipment and material.
- All access to sites, equipment and supervision will be done by a Transnet Freight Rail representative. All work will be undertaken under "dead" conditions and adherence must be given to the Transnet document: E4E "SAFETY ARRANGEMENTS AND PROCEDURAL COMPLIANCE WITH THE OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH AND SAFETY ACT (ACT 85 OF 1993) AND APPLICABLE REGULATIONS" at all times to ensure a safe working environment.
- 6.3 Transnet Freight Rail reserves the right to be present during any stage of the process.

7.1 The contractor must have a spill kit before any work is carried out

- 2.11 "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes reference to a juristic person;
- 2.14 "**rand value**" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes at excise duties;
- 2.15 "subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.16 **"total revenue"** bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;
- 2.17 **"trust"** means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and
- 2.18 **"trustee"** means any person including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to e administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 3.1 The Bidder obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 in the RFQ will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to anothe bidder.
- 3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.
- 3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.
- 3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

4.1 In terms of Regulation 5(2) and 6(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 4.3 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the R-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- 4.4 Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRDA of a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that he entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.6 A trust consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unface corated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 4.7 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.8 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- 4.9 A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
