a) INTRODUCTION

Saldanha Terminal is located at Saldanha Bay Local Municipality in Western Province at the following location; Latitude S: 32° 57' 23.54", Longitude S: 18° 02' 36.90"

Tankage:

- Two 83m³ each above pround (A/G) diesel storage tanks within a bund area.
- Tank No.1 the extrated remaining life calculation shows tank shell course 2 has the remaining life of 25 years.
- Tank No.2 the estimated remaining life calculation shows tank shell course 4 has the least remaining life of 21 years.

The tenderer is invited to tender for performing repairs on Tank 1&2 as per API 653 Inspector recommendations. All work performed should be done according to the following standards:

- All welding to meet the requirements of ASME 1X for procedure and welder qualification.
- All material Carbon steel to SANS 1413 Gr 300WA.
- Pits greater than 2mm to be repaired by overlay welding.
- All plate corners minimum 50mm radius
- Competed welds repairs will be inspected.

b) PROPOSED SCOPE OF WORK

The following summarizes the Tank 1&2 Repairs scope of work

2.1. TANK

2.1.1. Shell

- a) Repair the severely corroded shell section at the annular ring.
- b) Repair the severely corroded section with approved welding procedure.

2.1.2. Bottom Plates

- a) Repair pitting at the centre of the sump by welding metal deposition marked bottom plate.
- b) Repair topside pitting on floor plates and sump as marked for repairs.
- c) Repair drain pipe support brackets (150x150x6).

2.3. ROOF

- a) Roofing is fixed and self- supporting and roof places are in satisfactory condition.
- b) Repair the holes in the roof plate as well as the corroded nozzles.

2.4. VALVES/NOZZLES

- a) Repair/Replace both leaking inlet and oullet ball valves(6 inch)
- b) Install new bolts, nuts and washers on tank inlet and outlet isolation valve.
- c) Repair undercut and lack of fusion the internal welds on the nozzles

- 2.3 "B-BBEE status of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment (c.)
- 2.4 **"Bid"** means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by Transnet for the provision of goods, works or services;
- 2.5 **"Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act"** means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 [Act No. 53 of 2003];
- 2.6 **"comparative price"** means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can utilised have been taken into consideration;
- 2.7 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;
- 2.8 "contract" means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a bid by Transnet;
- 2.9 "EME" means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 [five] million or less;
- 2.10 "firm price" means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual

increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs and excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;

- 2.11 "functionality" means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the bid documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a bidder;
- 2.12 "non-firm prices" means all prices other than "firm" prices;
- 2.13 "person" includes reference to a juristic person;
- 2.14 "**rand value**" means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of bid invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;
- 2.15 "subcontract" means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;
- 2.16 **"total revenue"** bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promula ted in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;
- 2.17 **"trust"** means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and
- 2.18 **"trustee"** means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

- 3.1 The Bidder obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RF2 will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another bidder.
- Preference points had be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking into account aff-factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.
- 3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.
- 3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Bid will be awarded to the Bidder scoring the highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.
- 3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Bids have scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Bid will be the one scoring the highest score for functionality.
- 3.6 Should two or more Bids be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

4.1 In terms of Regulation 5(2) and 6(2) of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to a Bidder for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table below:

- 4.3 Bidders who qualify as EMEs in terms of the B-BBEE Act must submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.
- 4.4 Bidders other than EMEs must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy the reof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 A trust, consortium or joint verture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.6 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate bid.
- 4.7 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.
- 4.8 A person will not be awarded points for B-BBEE status level if it is indicated in the Bid documents that such a Bidder intends subcontracting more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not qualify for at least the same number of points that such a Bidder qualifies for, unless the intended subcontractor is an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
- 4.9 A person awarded a contract may not subcontract more than 25% [twenty-five per cent] of the value of the contract to any other enterprise that does not have an equal or higher B-BBEE status level than the person concerned, unless the contract is subcontracted to an EME that has the capability and ability to execute the subcontract.
