

REQUEST FOR QUOTATIONS

Transnet SOC Limited trading as Transnet Freight Rail invites tenders **Design, supply and installation of 11kV transmission line and laying out of 11kV XLPE cable in Tzaneen**

Only those tenderers who are registered with the CIDB, or capable of being so prior to evaluation of submissions, in a contractor grading designation equal to **2EP PE or 3PE or higher** or higher than a contractor grading designation determined in accordance with the sum tendered or a value determined in accordance with regulation 25 (1B) or 25(7A) of the Construction Industry Development Regulations, for a **2EP PE or 3PE or higher** or higher class of construction work, are eligible to have their tenders evaluated.

Tender documents may be obtained on and after Wednesday, **15 February 2017 until Thursday, 23 February 2017** from the Transnet Freight Rail, Tender Advice Centre, Ground floor, Nzasm building, c/o Paul Kruger and Minnaar streets, Pretoria during the office hours **08h00 to 15h00**, where they can be examined.
