F.1 General

F.1.1 Actions

F.1.1.1

The employer and each tenderer submitting a tender offer shall comply with these conditions of tender. In their dealings with each other, they shall discharge their duties and obligations as set out in F.2 and F.3, timeously and with integrity, and behave equitably, honestly and transparently, comply with all legal obligations and not engage in anti-competitive practices.

F.1.2

The employer and the tenderer and all their agents and employees involved in the tender process shall avoid conflicts of interest and where a conflict of interest is perceived or known, declare any such conflict of interest, indicating the nature of such conflict. Tenderer shall declare any potential conflict of interest in their tender submissions. Employees, agents and advisors of the employer shall declare any conflict of interest to whoever is responsible for overseeing the procurement process at the start of any deliberations relating to the procurement process or as soon as they become aware of such conflict, and abstain from any decisions where such conflict exists or recuse themselves from the procurement process, as appropriate.

Note: 1) A conflict of interest may arise due to a conflict of roles which might provide an incentive for improper acts in some circumstances. A conflict of interest can create an appearance of impropriety that can undermine confidence in the ability of that person to act properly in his or her position even if no improper acts result.
2) Conflicts of interest in respect of those engaged in the procurement process include direct, indirect or family interests in the tender or outcome of the procurement process and any personal bias, inclination, obligation, allegiance or loyalty which would in any way affect any decisions taken.

F.1.1.3

The employer shall not seek and a tenderer shall not submit a tender without having a firm intention and the capacity to proceed with the contract.

F.1.2 Tender Documents

The documents issued by the employer for the purpose of a tender offer are listed in the tender data.

F.1.3 Interpretation

F.1.3.1	The tender data and additional requirements contained in the tender schedules that are included in the returnable documents are deemed to be part of these conditions of tender.
F.1.3.2	These conditions of tender, the tender data and tender schedules which are only required for tender evaluation purposes, shall not form part of any contract arising from the invitation to tender.
F.1.3.3	For the purposes of these conditions of tender, the following definitions apply: a) conflict of interest means any situation in which: i) someone in a position of trust has competing professional or personal interests which make it difficult to fulfill his or her duties impartially; ii) an individual or organisation is in a position to exploit a professional or official capacity in some way for their personal or corporate benefit; or iii) incompatibility or contradictory interests exist between an employee and the organisation which employs that employee. b) comparative offer means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts it can be utilised to have been taken into consideration; c) corrupt practice means the offering, giving, receiving or soliciting of anything of value to influence the action of the employer or his staff or agents in the tender process; d) fraudulent practice means the misrepresentation of the facts in order to influence the tender process or the award of a contract arising from a tender offer to the detriment of the employer, including collusive practices intended to establish prices at artificial levels; e) organization means a company, firm, enterprise, association or other legal entity, whether incorporated or not, or a public body; f) functionality means the measurement according to the predetermined norms of a service or commodity designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and technical capacity and ability of a tenderer.
F.1.4	Communication and employer's agent Each communication between the employer and a tenderer shall be to or from the employer's agent only, and in a form that can be readily read, copied and recorded. Communications shall be in the English language. The employer shall not take any responsibility for non-receipt of communications from or by a tenderer. The name and contact details of the employer's agent are stated in the tender data.
F.1.5	Cancellation and Re-Invitation of Tenders An organ of state may, prior to the award of the tender, cancel a tender if- (a) due to changed circumstances, there is no longer a need for the services, works or goods requested; or (b) funds are no longer available to cover the total envisaged expenditure; or (c) no acceptable tenders are received.

The employer may accept or reject any variation, deviation, tender offer, or alternative tender offer, and may cancel the tender process and reject all tender offers at any time before the formation of a contract. The employer shall not accept or incur any liability to a tenderer for such cancellation and rejection, but will give written reasons for such action upon written request to do so.

The decision to cancel a tender must be published in the cidb website and in the government Tender Bulletin for the media in which the original tender invitation was advertised.

F.1.6 Procurement procedures

F.1.6.1 General

Unless otherwise stated in the tender data, a contract will, subject to F.3.13, be concluded with the tenderer who in terms of F.3.11 is the highest ranked or the tenderer scoring the highest number of tender evaluation points, as relevant, based on the tender submissions that are received at the closing time for tenders.

F.1.6.2 Competitive negotiation procedure

Where the tender data require that the competitive negotiation procedure is to be followed, tenderers shall submit tender offers in response to the proposed contract in the first round of submissions. Notwithstanding the requirements of F.3.4, the employer shall announce only the names of the tenderers who make a submission. The requirements of F.3.8 relating to the material deviations or qualifications which affect the competitive position of tenderers shall not apply.

All responsive tenderers, or not less than three responsive tenderers that are highest ranked in terms of the evaluation method and evaluation criteria stated in the tender data, shall be invited in each round to enter into competitive negotiations, based on the principle of equal treatment and keeping confidential the proposed solutions and associated information. Notwithstanding the provisions of F.2.17, the employer may request that tenders be clarified, specified and fine-tuned in order to improve a tenderer's competitive position provided that such clarification, specification, fine-tuning or additional information does not alter any fundamental aspects of the offers or impose substantial new requirements which restrict or distort competition or have a discriminatory effect.

a) an individual firm, or a joint venture as a whole, or any individual member of the joint venture fails to meet any of the collective or individual qualifying requirements;

b) the new partners to a joint venture were not prequalified in the first instance, either as individual firms or as another joint venture; or

c) in the opinion of the Employer, acceptance of the material change would compromise the outcome of the prequalification process.

F.3.2 Issue Addenda

If necessary, issue addenda that may amend or amplify the tender documents to each tenderer during the period from the date that tender documents are available until three days before the tender closing time stated in the Tender Data. If, as a result a tenderer applies for an extension to the closing time stated in the Tender Data, the Employer may grant such extension and, shall then notify all tenderers who drew documents.

F.3.3 Return late tender offers

Return tender offers received after the closing time stated in the Tender Data, unopened, (unless it is necessary to open a tender submission to obtain a forwarding address), to the tenderer concerned.

F.3.4 Opening of tender submissions

Unless the two-envelope system is to be followed, open valid tender submissions in the presence of tenderers' agents who choose to attend at the time and place stated in the tender data. Tender submissions for which acceptable reasons for withdrawal have been submitted will not be opened.

Announce at the meeting held immediately after the opening of tender submissions, at a venue indicated in the tender data, the name of each tenderer whose tender offer is opened and, where applicable, the total of his prices, number of points claimed for its BBEE status level and time for completion for the main tender offer only.

F.3.5 Two-envelope system

F.3.5.1

Where stated in the tender data that a two-envelope system is to be followed, open only the technical proposal of valid tenders in the presence of tenderers'

agents who choose to attend at the time and place stated in the tender data and announce the name of each tenderer whose technical proposal is opened.

F.3.5.2 Evaluate functionality of the technical proposals offered by tenderers, then advise tenderers who remain in contention for the award of the contract of the time and place when the financial proposals will be opened. Open only the financial proposals of tenderers, who score in the functionality evaluation more than the minimum number of points for functionality stated in the tender data, and announce the score obtained for the technical proposals and the total price and any points claimed on BBEE status level. F.3.6 Non-disclosure

Not disclose to tenderers, or to any other person not officially concerned with such processes, information relating to the evaluation and comparison of tender offers, the final evaluation price and recommendations for the award of a contract, until after the award of the contract to the successful tenderer.

F.3.7 Grounds for rejection and disqualification

Determine whether there has been any effort by a tenderer to influence the processing of tender offers and instantly disqualify a tenderer (and his tender offer) if it is established that he engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices.

F.3.8 Test for responsiveness

F.3.8.1 Determine, after opening and before detailed evaluation, whether each tender offer properly received:

- a) complies with the requirements of these Conditions of Tender,
- b) has been properly and fully completed and signed, and
- c) is responsive to the other requirements of the tender documents.

F.3.8.2

A responsive tender is one that conforms to all the terms, conditions, and specifications of the tender documents without material deviation or qualification. A material deviation or qualification is one which, in the Employer's opinion, would:

6.2 Blacklisting is a mechanism used to exclude a company/person from future business with Transnet for a specified period. The decision to blacklist is based on one of the grounds for blacklisting. 6.3 Depending on the seriousness of the misconduct and the strategic importance of the Goods/Services, in addition to blacklisting a company/person from future business, Transnet may decide to terminate some or all existing contracts with the company/person as well.

a) Has, in bad faith, withdrawn such Tender after the advertised closing date and time for the receipt of Tenders;

b) has, after being notified of the acceptance of his Tender, failed or refused to sign a contract when called upon to do so in terms of any condition forming part of the Tender documents;

c) has carried out any contract resulting from such Tender in an unsatisfactory manner or has breached any condition of the contract;

d) has offered, promised or given a bribe in relation to the obtaining or execution of the contract;

e) has acted in a fraudulent or improper manner or in bad faith towards Transnet or any Government Department or towards any public body, Enterprise or person;

f) has made any incorrect statement in a certificate or other communication with regard to the Local Content of his Goods or his B-BBEE status and is unable to prove to the satisfaction of Transnet that:

- 7.1 The Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor hereby declares that no previous transgressions resulting in a serious breach of any law, including but not limited to, corruption, fraud, theft, extortion and contraventions of the Competition Act 89 of 1998, which occurred in the last 5 (five) years with any other public sector undertaking, government department or private sector company that could justify its exclusion from its registration on the Tenderer's / Service Provider's / Contractor's database or any tendering process.

 - b) A Transnet employee has private interests or personal considerations or has an affiliation or a relationship which affects, or may affect, or may be perceived to affect his / her judgment in action in the best interest of Transnet, or could affect the employee's motivations for acting in a particular manner, or which could result in, or be perceived as favouritism or nepotism.

9.2 A Transnet employee uses his / her position, or privileges or information obtained while acting in

the capacity as an employee for:

a) Private gain or advancement; or

b) The expectation of private gain, or advancement, or any other advantage accruing to the

employee must be declared in a prescribed form.

Thus, conflicts of interest of any Tender committee member or any person involved in the sourcing process must be declared in a prescribed form.

9.3 If a Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor has or becomes aware of a conflict of interest i.e. a

family, business and / or social relationship between its owner(s) / member(s) / director(s) / partner(s) / shareholder(s) and a Transnet employee / member of Transnet's Board of Directors in respect of a Tender which will be considered for the Tender process, the Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor:

a) must disclose the interest and its general nature, in the Request for Proposal ("RFP") declaration

form; or

b) must notify Transnet immediately in writing once the circumstances has arisen.

9.4 The Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor shall not lend to or borrow any money from or enter

into any monetary dealings or transactions, directly or indirectly, with any committee member or any person involved in the sourcing process, where this is done, Transnet shall be entitled forthwith to rescind the contract and all other contracts with the Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor.

10 MONITORING

10.1 Transnet will be responsible for appointing an independent Monitor to:

a) Conduct random monitoring of compliance to the provisions of this Integrity Pact for contracts

entered into between Transnet and the Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor for less than R100,000,000 (one hundred million Rand) in value;

b) Monitor compliance to the provisions of this Integrity Pact for contracts entered into between

Transnet and the Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor for greater than R100,000,000 (one hundred million Rand) in value; and

c) Investigate any allegation of violation of any provisions of this Integrity Pact for contracts entered into between Transnet and the Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor, irrespective of value.

10.2 The Monitor will be subjected to Transnet's Terms of Conditions of Contract for the Provision of

Services to Transnet, as well as to Transnet's Service Provider Code of Conduct.

11 EXAMINATION OF FINANCIAL RECORDS, DOCUMENTATION AND/OR ELECTRONIC DATA

For the purpose of Monitoring, as stipulated above, the Monitor shall be entitled to:

a) Examine the financial records, documentation and or electronic date of Tenderer / Service Provider

/ Contractor / Transnet. The Tenderer / Service Provider / Transnet shall provide all requested information / documentation / data to the Monitor and shall extend all help possible for the

purpose of such examination.

12 DISPUTE RESOLUTION

12.1 Transnet recognises that trust and good faith are pivotal to its relationship with its Tenderer /

Service Provider / Contractor. When a dispute arises between Transnet and its Tenderer / Service

Provider / Contractor, the parties should use their best endeavours to resolve the dispute in an amicable manner, whenever possible. Litigation in bad faith negates the principles of trust and good faith on which commercial relationships are based. Accordingly, following a blacklisting process as mentioned in paragraph 6 above, Transnet will not do business with a company that litigates against it in bad faith or is involved in any action that reflects bad faith on its part. Litigation in bad faith includes, but is not limited to the following instances:

- a) **Vexatious proceedings:** these are frivolous proceedings which have been instituted without proper grounds;
- b) **Perjury:** where a Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor make a false statement either in giving evidence or on an affidavit;
- c) **Scurrilous allegations:** where a Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor makes allegations regarding a senior Transnet employee which are without proper foundation, scandalous, abusive or defamatory; and
- d) **Abuse of court process:** when a Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor abuses the court process in order to gain a competitive advantage during a Tender process.

13 GENERAL

13.1 This Integrity Pact is governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Republic of South Africa.

13.2 The actions stipulated in this Integrity Pact are without prejudice to any other legal action that may follow in accordance with the provisions of the law relating to any civil or criminal proceedings.

13.3 The validity of this Integrity Pact shall cover all the tendering processes and will be valid for an indefinite period unless cancelled by either Party.

13.4 Should one or several provisions of this Integrity Pact turn out to be invalid the remainder of this Integrity Pact remains valid.

13.5 Should a Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor be confronted with dishonest, fraudulent or corruptive behaviour of one or more Transnet employees, Transnet expects its Tenderer / Service Provider / Contractor to report this behaviour directly to a senior Transnet official / employee or alternatively by using Transnet's "Tip-Off Anonymous" hotline number 0800 003 056, whereby your confidentiality is guaranteed.

The Parties hereby declare that each of them has read and understood the clauses of this Integrity Pact and shall attendere by it. To the best of the Parties' knowledge and belief, the information provided in this Integrity Pact is true and correct.

1. Purpose

The parties to this Agreement have a business relationship under which each party may disclose its Confidential Information to the other for the purpose of planning, developing and/or constructing a new Supply And Installation Of Various Electrical Lightning Protection For East Gate, Main Gate And Bayvue Gates (the Purpose). Each party (the receiving party) shall treat as confidential all information and know-how which it may receive from the other party (the disclosing party) in terms of this Agreement (hereinafter referred to as "confidential information"), and shall not divulge to any other party in any circumstances any such confidential information, and, in particular, any such confidential information as is covered by the National Key Points Act (Act No. 102 of 1980), whether during the currency of this Agreement or at any time thereafter, without the prior written consent of the disclosing party.

2. Definition

"Confidential Information" means any information, technical data, or know-how, including, but not limited to, that which relates to research, product plans, products, services, customers, markets, software, developments, inventions, processes, designs, drawings, engineering, hardware configuration information, marketing or finances.

3. Exclusions

Confidential Information does not include information, technical data or know-how which:
3.1. is in the possession of the receiving party at the time of disclosure as shown by the receiving party's files and records immediately prior to the time of disclosure;
3.2. prior or after the time of disclosure becomes part of the public knowledge or literature, not as a result of any inaction or action of the receiving party;
3.3. is developed by the receiving party through its independent resources without reference to the disclosing party's Confidential Information;

- 3.4. is disclosed to the receiving party by a third party without restriction and, to the knowledge of the receiving party, without violation of any obligation of confidentiality; or
- 3.5. is approved for release by the disclosing party in writing.

4. Non-Disclosure of Confidential Information

- 4.1. The parties to this Agreement agree not to use the Confidential Information disclosed to it by the other party for its own use or for any purpose except to carry out the Purpose as contained in this Agreement. Neither party will disclose any Confidential Information of the other party to third parties except those directors, officers, employees, consultants and agents who are required to have the information in order to carry out the discussions of the contemplated Purpose. Each party will notify those directors, officers, employees, consultants and agents to whom Confidential Information of the other party is disclosed or who have access to Confidential Information of the other party that they are bound by the obligations of this Non-Disclosure Agreement.

- 4.2. Each party agrees that it will take all reasonable measures to protect the secrecy of and avoid disclosure or use of Confidential Information of the other party in order to prevent it from falling into the public domain or the possession of persons other than those persons authorised hereunder to have any such information, which measures shall include the highest degree of care that either party utilises to protect its own Confidential Information of a similar nature. Each party agrees to notify the other party in writing of any misuse or misappropriation of such Confidential Information of the other party which may come to its attention.

5. Promotion of Access to Information Act, No.2 of 2000

- 5.1. All information relating to the disclosing party and which the disclosing party has indicated to the receiving party in writing to be confidential information, shall be deemed to be confidential information.
- 5.2. No provision of this Agreement shall be construed in such a way that the disclosing party is deemed to have granted its consent to the receiving party to disclose the whole or any part of the confidential information in the event that the receiving party receives a request for the whole or any part of the confidential information in terms of the provisions of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, No.2 of 2000, as may be amended from time to time ("the Act").

- 5.3. Subject to the provisions of sub-clause 5.3 below, the disclosure of confidential information by the receiving party otherwise than in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement will entitle the disclosing party to institute action for breach of confidence against the receiving party, as envisaged by Section 65 of Act No.2 of 2000.
- 5.4. The receiving party acknowledges that the provisions of sub-clause 5.2 above shall not be construed in such a manner as to exclude the applicability of any other grounds of refusal contained in Act No.2 of 2000 which may be applicable in the event that the receiving party receives a request for the whole or any part of the confidential information in terms of Act No.2 of 2000.

6. Non-Solicitation

During the two-year period following the execution of this Agreement, neither party will solicit for employment, on its own behalf or that of any other person, any officer, director or employee of the other party at the level of director, vice-president or higher with whom the soliciting party became acquainted during the course of the discussions contemplated by this Agreement; provided, that the foregoing shall not

be deemed to prohibit either party or a subsidiary of such party from making a general, public solicitation of employment in the ordinary course of such party or subsidiary's business, provided that such solicitation is not directed specifically to employees of the other party.

7. Mandatory Disclosure

In the event that either party or their respective directors, officers, employees, consultants or agents are requested or required by legal process to disclose any of the Confidential Information of the other party, the party required to make such disclosure shall give prompt notice so that the other party may seek a protective order or other appropriate relief. In the event that such protective order is not obtained, the party required to make such disclosure shall disclose only that portion of the Confidential Information, which its counsel advises that it is legally required to disclose.

8. Variation, Addition or Cancellation

No variation of, addition to, cancellation or novation of this Agreement in its entirety or of any term or condition thereof shall be of any force or effect unless such amendment or cancellation is reduced to writing and signed by both parties.

9. No License Granted

Nothing in this Agreement is intended to grant any rights to either party under any patent, copyright, trade secret or other intellectual property right nor shall this Agreement grant either party any rights in or to the other party's Confidential Information, except the limited right to review such Confidential Information solely for the purposes of the contemplated business relationship between the parties.

10. No Representations

No party makes any representation or warranty as to the accuracy or completeness of any Confidential Information provided hereunder. Neither party shall have any liability to the other arising from, or related to, the other party's use of Confidential Information provided hereunder.

11. Term

The foregoing commitments of either party in this Agreement shall survive any termination of the business relationship under the contemplated Purpose between the parties, and shall continue relative to any Confidential Information disclosed hereunder for a period of 10 (ten) years following the disclosure of such Confidential Information.

12. Miscellaneous

This Agreement shall be binding upon and for the benefit of the undersigned parties, their successors and assigns, provided that Confidential Information of either party may not be assigned without the prior written consent of the disclosing party. Failure to enforce any provision of this Agreement shall not constitute a waiver of any term hereof.

13. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the Republic of South Africa, and shall be binding upon the parties hereto in South Africa and worldwide.

14. Disputes

Any dispute or difference arising out of or relating to this Confidentiality Agreement shall be referred to arbitration and settled by arbitration according to the rules then in effect of the Arbitration Foundation of Southern Africa. Such arbitration shall be held in Johannesburg, and conducted in the English language before 1 (one) arbitrator appointed in accordance with the said rules. The arbitrator shall apply the law chosen by the parties elsewhere in this Agreement to the merits of the dispute. This Agreement to arbitrate shall be enforceable in, and judgement upon any award may be entered in any court of any country having appropriate jurisdiction.

15. Remedies

Each party agrees that its obligations hereunder are necessary and reasonable in order to protect the other party and the other party's business, and expressly agrees that monetary damages may be inadequate to compensate the other party for any breach by either party of any covenants and agreements set forth herein. Accordingly, each party agrees and acknowledges that any such violation or threatened violation may cause irreparable injury to the other party and that, in addition to any other remedies that may be available, in law, in equity or otherwise, the other party shall be entitled to obtain injunctive relief against the threatened breach of this Agreement or the continuation of any such breach, without the necessity of proving actual damages.

1.3 Transnet reserves the right to require of a Tenderer, either before a Tender is adjudicated or at any time subsequently, to substantiate any claim in regard to preferences, in any manner required by Transnet.

2. GENERAL DEFINITIONS

2.1 "all applicable taxes" include value-added tax, pay as you earn, income tax, unemployment insurance fund contributions and skills development levies;

2.2 "B-BBEE" means broad-based black economic empowerment as defined in section 1 of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;

2.3 "B-BBEE status of contributor" means the B-BBEE status received by a measured entity based on its overall performance using the relevant scorecard contained in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act;

2.4 "Tender" means a written offer in a prescribed or stipulated form in response to an invitation by Transnet for the provision of goods, works or services;

2.5 "Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act" means the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 [Act No. 53 of 2003];

2.6 "comparative price" means the price after the factors of a non-firm price and all unconditional discounts that can utilised have been taken into consideration;

2.7 "consortium or joint venture" means an association of persons for the purpose of combining their expertise, property, capital, efforts, skills and knowledge in an activity for the execution of a contract;

2.8 **"contract"** means the agreement that results from the acceptance of a Tender by Transnet;

2.9 **"EME"** means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R5 [five] million or less as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of R10 [ten] million or less as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928;

2.10 **"firm price"** means the price that is only subject to adjustments in accordance with the actual increase or decrease resulting from the change, imposition, or abolition of customs and excise duty and any other duty, levy, or tax, which, in terms of the law or regulation, is binding on the contractor and demonstrably has an influence on the price of any supplies, or the rendering costs of any service, for the execution of the contract;

2.11 **"functionality"** means the measurement according to predetermined norms, as set out in the Tender documents, of a service or commodity that is designed to be practical and useful, working or operating, taking into account, among other factors, the quality, reliability, viability and durability of a service and the technical capacity and ability of a Tenderer;

2.12 **"non-firm prices"** means all prices other than "firm" prices;

2.13 **"person"** includes reference to a juristic person;

2.14 **"QSE"** means any enterprise with an annual total revenue between R5 [five] million and R35 [thirty five] million as per the 2007 version of the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice and means any enterprise with an annual total revenue of between R10 [ten] million and R50 [fifty] million as per the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11 October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928

2.15 **"rand value"** means the total estimated value of a contract in South African currency, calculated at the time of Tender invitations, and includes all applicable taxes and excise duties;

2.16 **"subcontract"** means the primary contractor's assigning or leasing or making out work to, or employing another person to support such primary contractor in the execution of part of a project in terms of the contract;

2.17 **"total revenue"** bears the same meaning assigned to this expression in the Codes of Good Practice on Black Economic Empowerment, issued in terms of section 9(1) of the Broad-Based Black Empowerment Act and promulgated in the Government Gazette on 9 February 2007;

2.18 **"trust"** means the arrangement through which the property of one person is made over or bequeathed to a trustee to administer such property for the benefit of another person; and

2.19 **"trustee"** means any person, including the founder of a trust, to whom property is bequeathed in order for such property to be administered for the benefit of another person.

3. ADJUDICATION USING A POINT SYSTEM

3.1 The Tenderer obtaining the highest number of total points for the evaluation criteria as enumerated in Section 2 of the RFP will be awarded the contract, unless objective criteria justifies the award to another Tenderer.

3.2 Preference points shall be calculated after prices have been brought to a comparative basis taking

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into account all factors of non-firm prices and all unconditional discounts.

3.3 Points scored will be rounded off to 2 [two] decimal places.

3.4 In the event of equal points scored, the Tender will be awarded to the Tenderer scoring the

highest number of preference points for B-BBEE.

3.5 However, when functionality is part of the evaluation process and two or more Tenders have

scored equal points including equal preference points for B-BBEE, the successful Tender will be the

one scoring the highest score for functionality.

3.6 Should two or more Tenders be equal in all respect, the award shall be decided by the drawing of

lots.

4. POINTS AWARDED FOR B-BBEE STATUS LEVEL OF CONTRIBUTION

4.1 In terms of the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2011, preference points shall be awarded to

a Tenderer for attaining the B-BBEE status level of contribution in accordance with the table

4.2 Tenderers who qualify as EMEs in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice must

submit a certificate issued by an Accounting Officer as contemplated in the CCA or a Verification

Agency accredited by SANAS or a Registered Auditor. Registered auditors do not need to meet the

prerequisite for IRBA's approval for the purpose of conducting verification and issuing EME's with

B-BBEE Status Level Certificates.

4.3 Tenderers who qualify as EMEs in terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice issued on 11

October 2013 in terms of Government Gazette No. 36928 are only required to obtain a sworn

affidavit on an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R10 million

or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership.

4.4 In terms of the 2007 version of the Codes of Good Practice, Tenderers other than EMEs must

- submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.5 The Department of Trade and Industry recently revised the Codes of Good Practice on 11 October 2013 [Government Gazette No. 36928]. The Revised Codes will replace the Black Economic Empowerment Codes of Good Practice issued on 9 February 2007. The Revised Codes provide for a transitional period ending 30 April 2015. During the transitional period, companies may elect to be measured in terms of the Revised Codes or the 2007 version of the Codes. Companies which are governed by Sector-specific Codes will be measured in terms of those Sector Codes.
- 4.6 As such, Transnet will accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes. Transnet will also continue to accept B-BBEE certificates issued in terms of the 2007 version of the Codes provided it was issued before 1 May 2015. Thereafter, Transnet will only accept B-BBEE certificates issued based on the Revised Codes.
- 4.7 In terms of the Revised Codes of Good Practice, Tenderers who qualify as QSEs must comply with all the elements of B-BBEE for the purposes of measurement. QSEs that are at least 51% or 100% Black owned are only required to obtain a sworn affidavit in an annual basis confirming that the entity has an Annual Total Revenue of R50 million or less and the entity's Level of Black ownership. Large enterprises must submit their original and valid B-BBEE status level verification certificate or a certified copy thereof, substantiating their B-BBEE rating issued by a Registered Auditor approved by IRBA or a Verification Agency accredited by SANAS.
- 4.8 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for its B-BBEE status level as a legal entity, provided that the entity submits its B-BBEE status level certificate.
- 4.9 A trust, consortium or joint venture will qualify for points for their B-BBEE status level as an unincorporated entity, provided that the entity submits their consolidated B-BBEE scorecard as if they were a group structure, and that such a consolidated B-BBEE scorecard is prepared for every separate Tender.
- 4.10 Tertiary institutions and public entities will be required to submit their B-BBEE status level certificates in terms of the specialised scorecard contained in the B-BBEE Codes of Good Practice.

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C3: Scope of Work

C3.1 Works Information

The scope of work covers the requirements for the supply, installation and testing of lightning protection systems for the Port entrances in the Port of Richards Bay, these being Bayvue Gate, East Gate and Main Gate.

1. Description of the works

1.1 Service Conditions

1.1.1 All equipment offered shall be rated for continuous operation under the following conditions:

Altitude – Sea level
Ambient air temperature – Max. 35 deg.C; Min.-5 deg.C
Humidity - As high as 96%
Lightning Conditions- Severe

Atmosphere- Highly saline with heavy corrosive industrial, chemical and dust-laden nature. Frequent heavy rains driven by winds reaching speeds of 100 Km/h and above.
Current- The peak lightning current and its rate of rise shall be regarded as severe when i_{max} 200kA.
Voltage- The highest cloud potential shall be assumed to be more than 100MV, where; $Q=CV$, where Q is assumed at 100C and C to be 10-7 F

1.2 Equipment and Materials

1.2.1 Equipment and materials to be used shall be of high quality, and shall comply with all relevant specifications, codes as mentioned in this specification as well as Occupational Health and Safety Act of 1993(Act 85 of 1993).
1.2.2 Where equipment and material does not comply with the relevant specifications it shall be submitted to National Ports Authority's Engineer for approval.
1.2.3 All materials used for the lightning protection system shall withstand the electric and electromagnetic effects of lightning current and predictable stresses without being damaged.
1.2.4 Materials and sizes shall be chosen bearing in mind the possibility of corrosion of either the lightning protection system or the structure to be protected.
1.2.5 Components of the lightning protection system shall be manufactured from materials listed in Table 8 of SANS 10313, provided they have sufficient electrical conductivity and corrosion resistance.
1.2.6 Characteristics of materials suitable for use in the manufacture for component parts of lightning protection systems are recommended in Table 2 & 3 of the code of practice for protection of structures against lightning.

1.3 Air Terminals and Down-conductors

1.3.1 All conductors must be in accordance with the requirements of BSS 1474 or American Standards Specification 6063. All aluminium conductors shall have a cross-section area of not less than 30mm² (domestic dwelling only) or 50mm² for all other applications. The dimensions of flat section conductors to be mounted in stand-off guides, the cross-section area of the conductor must be not less than 70mm² to give adequate mechanical strength.

1.4 Conductor Guides

1.4.1 The conductor must be mounted in aluminium alloy guides conforming with the material specification given in 4.1 above. The guides must allow for free longitudinal movement of the conductor to cater for expansion and contraction of the system caused by temperature variation. The minimum thickness of any part of the guide shall not be less than 3 mm. The guides must be securely attached to the structure using two stainless steel screws and plugs, the use of plated screws is not permitted.

1.4.2 The conductor system shall be supported in guides so that an air gap exists at all times between the aluminium and the surface of the structure, the guides being seated upon plastic or other similar insulating material. Should conductors be installed directly upon the surface of concrete or cement plaster, an insulating strip is to be installed over its whole length to prevent contact between the two surfaces. Guides shall be installed to support the conductor at intervals not exceeding 1,2 metres horizontally or 1,5 metres vertically.

1.4.3 N.B.: No part of an aluminium conductor system must be allowed to come into direct contact with concrete or cement plaster as this may cause the aluminium to corrode.

1.5 Expansion Loops

1.5.1 Where conductors are installed horizontally without deviation from a straight line over long distances, expansion loops must be provided at distances not exceeding 30 metres. These expansion loops must have a cross-sectional area which is at least equal to that of the conductor.

1.6 Protection of Down Conductors

1.6.1 Where external down-conductors are installed in areas which are readily accessible to the public, the lower ends of the conductors shall be enclosed in a semi-rigid insulating material. In the case of a circular section conductor this shall comprise a 2 metre length of 20 mm diameter P.V.C. conduit. This conduit shall be securely attached to the wall by means of galvanized steel saddles fixed with stainless steel screws and plugs, spaced at intervals not exceeding 1 m. Where a flat section conductor is used this shall be covered by a similar length of 25 mm P.V.C. conduit. The lower end of the conduit shall be positioned as close as practicable to ground level, i.e. immediately above an aluminium to copper joint. The ends of the conduit shall not be sealed.

1.7 Earthing Electrodes

1.7.1 Earthing electrodes must consist of either copper-clad steel rods not less than 12mm in diameter and having a minimum copper thickness of 0,20 mm driven into the ground, or a 50mm² (35mm² for domestic dwellings) bare copper conductor buried in a trench, or a combination thereof. Where copper clad steel electrodes are used they must have a suitable bond between the steel core and copper exterior to prevent moisture ingress between the two metals. Where it is necessary to extend earth rods, an electrolytically compatible corrosion resistant coupling device, which prevents ingress or moisture into the joint shall be used. The copper conductor below the down-conductor joint shall be covered by a semi-rigid P.V.C. conduit for a distance of approximately 200 mm above ground and 400 mm below ground.

1.8 Joints Above Ground/ on ground box

1.8.1 Circular section aluminium conductors shall be joined by aluminium ferrules or lugs which are securely crimped into place. Aluminium lugs must be bolted together using 10mm diameter aluminium bolts and washers. The material specification for these components must conform with that laid down in paragraph 4.1. Alternatively heavily tinned copper lugs and ferrules may be used. The lugs should be joined together by means of 10mm diameter copper, brass or bronze bolts and washers. Care should be taken to inhibit corrosion where dissimilar metals are used by thoroughly cleaning the surfaces of the metal before assembly and subsequently sealing the joint with an inert tenacious compound or tape.

1.8.2 Flat section aluminium conductors shall be joined by double riveting, using aluminium rivets which comply with the material specification laid down in 4.1. Alternatively 2 x 6mm diameter stainless steel bolts, nuts and washers may be used. Fold over type bends will not be permitted.

1.8.3 Down-conductors are to be terminated approximately 200mm above finished ground level. Circular section aluminium is to be joined to a 50mm² (35 mm² in the case of domestic dwellings) stranded copper conductor by securely crimping in place two heavily tinned lugs and bolting these together using 10mm diameter copper, brass or bronze nuts, bolts and washers and be in a PVC 100mm x 100mm surface mounted box with screw closable cover.

1.8.4 NB: Under no circumstances shall aluminium conductors be buried in the ground.

1.9 Joints below Ground

1.9.1 A joint in the stranded copper conductor which forms part of the earthing system must be made by using a crimped copper ferrule clamping (not lugs) using two copper line taps of suitable dimensions, or exothermic welding. The copper earth conductor must be joined to an earth rod by either clamping, using a standard earth rod clamp or copper line tap or by exothermic welding. Joints which are made between dissimilar metals (i.e. copper conductor to galvanized steel water main), must be thoroughly cleaned before assembly.

1.9.2 They shall be rendered watertight using waterproof adhesive tape on a suitable compound for a minimum distance of 200mm in all directions from the joint.

1.9.3 Positioning of the earth pit - minimum of 1m away from the wall and directly in line with the down conductor. The opening should be approximately 40mm above the surrounding ground. The joint between the earthing rod and the down conductor should easily be inspected by removing the lid. Earth pit shall be 300mm x 300mm x 300mm deep with an opening of 40mm. Earth pit lid shall be steel led and be a waterproof earth pit. A commercial earth pit may be used.

1.10 Bonds

1.10.1 Where it is necessary to bond the aluminium conductor to any other metallic surface, this must be done by bolting or riveting. When attaching aluminium to a dissimilar metal the joints are to be thoroughly cleaned and sealed to prevent corrosion.

1.11 Down Conductors for steel framed structures

1.11.1 Where the framework of a building is constructed of structural steel columns, these may be used in place of down conductors providing the separating distance between them does not exceed 30 metres. The upper ends of the columns must be bonded to the air terminal systems and the lower ends to the earthing system.

1.12 Responsibility for Work

- 1.12.1 The Contractor shall be responsible for the complete installation of lightning protection system including evaluating, testing, earthing conductors, surge protection devices, spikes etc. as required for the proposed buildings and structures.
- 1.12.2 The Contractor tenderer shall undertake to repair all faults due to bad workmanship and/or the use of faulty materials and to replace all defective materials within six months after the installation date.
- 1.12.3 The Contractor shall rectify all the defects to the satisfaction of Employer's Agent, that may become apparent during the guarantee period.
- 1.12.4 The Contractor may be required to carry out builders work such as cutting of concrete columns and coring of holes for testing of continuity of the existing steelwork or cabling. Good contact between reinforcing bars should be ensured.

- 1.12.5 The Contractor shall be responsible for protection of electronic and information equipment by installing lightning protection zones with electromagnetic shields as well relevant class III surge protection devices.

- 1.12.6 The Contractor shall be responsible for conducting appropriate tests to prove equipment's immunity against lightning stroke damages as defined in IEC 61000-4-5, IEC 61000-4-9 and IEC 61000-4-10.

- 1.12.7 The Contractor shall be responsible for providing relevant test points for the proposed building and structure for maintenance and future test purposes.

1.13 Applicable Information

- 1.13.1 **Electrical effect** – The current discharged through the earth electrode resistance produces a resistive volt drop which may raise the potential of the system to a high value relative to true earth.
- 1.13.2 **Side flashing** – The point of strike may be raised to a high potential, and there is a risk of flashover from the protection system to any metal parts of the structure.
- 1.13.3 **Thermal effect** – The thermal effect of a lightning discharge is confined to the temperature rise of the conductor through which the current passes

- 1.13.4 **Mechanical effect** – When a high current is discharged along parallel conductors in close proximity or along a single conductor with sharp bends, a different mechanical effect is exerted by a lightning flash. This is due to a sudden rise of 30 000K in air temperature and the resulting explosive expansion of the adjacent air in the channel along which the charge is propagated.

- 1.13.5 **Primary source of interference** – The primary electromagnetic source of interference to the information and electronic equipment is the lightning current and the magnetic field.

- 1.13.6 **Magnetic induction effects** – The magnetic induction effects are mainly determined by the rise of the magnetic field to the maximum value.

1.14 Protection against corrosion

- 1.14.1 The tenderer shall ensure that atmospheric, chemical and or electrolytic corrosion of copper and other metals is prevented from occurring when used for the lightning protection system.
- 1.14.2 The contact surfaces of dissimilar metals shall be kept completely dry and protected against ingress of moisture to prevent the acceleration of electrolytic corrosion.

1.15 Inspection, Testing and Guarantee

- 1.14.3 Although copper is highly resistant to many types of chemical attack, lead coating shall be recommended wherever subjected to severe corrosion due to presence of sulphur compounds.
- 1.14.4 Stainless steel material of dissimilar grading shall not be used unless prior approval is obtained.
- 1.14.5 The metals of the lightning protection system shall be compatible with metals used externally or on any other structure over which the system passes or with which it may make contact.
- 1.14.6 All fittings used shall be resistant to corrosive agents; or otherwise suitably protected.
- 1.14.7 Earth conductors between test points and earth electrodes shall be protected against corrosion where they enter the ground for a distance of 0.3m above and below ground level. PVC sleeves are considered to be a suitable means of protection.

- 1.15.1 The Employer reserves the right to inspect the installation and the equipment to be used at any time during the execution of the works.
- 1.15.2 All lightning protection systems shall be inspected and certified by an accredited person after completion of the installation, to verify conformance as required by Code of Practice, SANS 10313.
- 1.15.3 All components of the lightning protection system shall be inspected to ensure that they are in good condition and are capable of performing their designed functions.
- 1.15.4 The Contractor shall ensure that all elements of the electrical installation have been incorporated into the protected space by bonding or extensions to the lightning protection system.
- 1.15.5 The mechanical condition of all conductors, bonds, joints and earth electrodes shall be checked and observations noted.
- 1.15.6 The contractor shall undertake to repair and replace all faults and faulty materials due to bad workmanship during a period of six months
- 1.15.7 The contractor shall be required to guarantee the installation for a period of twelve (12) months.
- 1.15.8 The contractor shall on completion of all portions installation or any subsequent modification to it, be required to conduct tests and checks as recommended in the applicable SANS, IEC and BS documents as listed in clause 2.0 of this specification.
- 1.15.9 The tenderer shall conduct all tests refer to in clause 10.8 above at fixed intervals; preferably not exceeding 12 months. It is emphasized that before disconnecting a lightning protection earth, it must be tested using sensitive voltage testing device to ensure that it not "live".
- 1.15.10 The tenderer shall be required to submit a Certificate of Compliance as per SANS 10313 (2010) on completion of the installation.
- 1.15.11 All test procedures and recommendations will fully comply with the SANS Code of Practice 10313 (2010) in conjunction with SANS 62305-1-2-3-4:2011 and IEC 62305-1-2-3-4: 2010

1.16 Maintenance

1.16.1 The tenderer shall advise TNPA of any additional maintenance requirements resulting from periodic inspections and tests, as recommended in section 10 above.

ANNEXURE A
SCHEDULE OF REQUIREMENTS

1. DETAILED SCOPE

1.1 Transnet National Ports Authority requires the design and installation of a lightning protection system for the proposed gate houses building, and associated electronic equipment in the Port Richards Bay as detailed below. This shall include:-

1.2 Proposed Main Gate house, Bayview and East gate houses

- a) Installation of a comprehensive lightning protection including all earthing and ground test point.
- b) Installation of surge protection devices for all distribution boards in the gate houses and kiosks.
- c) Installation of surge protection devices for network switches and electronic equipment in the gate houses.

1.3 The tenderer shall perform a detailed assessment and testing (as per SANS 10313), to estimate the risks of exposure to lightning strikes for the above building to enable a detailed proposal for the required lightning installation to be provided.

1.4 The tenderer shall be required to provide new test points for the gate houses.

1.5 The tenderers design proposal shall provide for effective surge protection against transient voltages.

1.6 The tenderer shall specify the protection class and type for the surge protection devices intended for use for low voltage circuits. This device shall have characteristics for lightning current and surge arresting, equipment protection and status display (red/green or fuse blown/healthy display).

1.7 This surge protection device shall be comprehensive with protection characteristics for electrical power supply and interfaces for measurement and control technology, data processing and telecommunications.

1.8 The tenderer shall submit a breakdown of all individual items and costs as per the proposed design for the installation at the time of tendering.

2.	DESIGN REQUIREMENTS	2.1 The tenderer shall be required to design new systems for lightning protection systems to be used for the above building / structure in accordance to SANS 10313. The tenderer shall not be limited to one offer or proposal. 2.2 The tenderer's design shall be based on the severe atmospheric conditions (design criteria to based on worst cases) as stated in clause 5.1 of this specification. 2.3 Tenderer shall be required to provide details of their design calculations at the time of tendering based on their evaluation of the values of Na and Nc as stated in clause 4.1.9 of SANS 10313 in order to select the most accurate level of protection in terms of their design proposal. Sketches shall accompany these where deemed necessary. 2.4 The tenderer's design proposals shall be in accordance with all the relevant codes (specify) for lightning protection of buildings and structures. 2.5 The designs level and protection levels class of surge protection devices offered shall be clearly stated by tenderer in their proposal.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS	3.1 The tenderer shall be required to be registered and listed with South African Bureau of Standards and the listing number shall be included in the above mentioned compliance certificate. 3.2 The tenderer shall be required to issue compliance certificates for lightning protection systems (SANS 10313) for all work done to the satisfaction of Transnet National Ports Authority. Only an original certificate shall be issued and accepted. 3.3 Preference shall be given to tenderers who are registered with Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB)
4.	GENERAL INFORMATION	4.1 Transnet National Ports Authority does not bind itself to accept the lowest, or any tender nor will it assign any reason for the rejection of a tender. 4.2 All annexures are to be returned with tender. 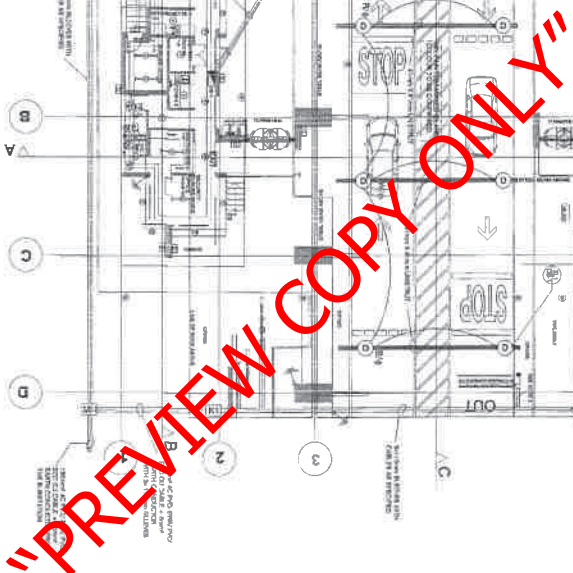
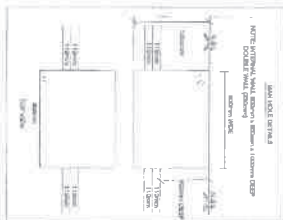
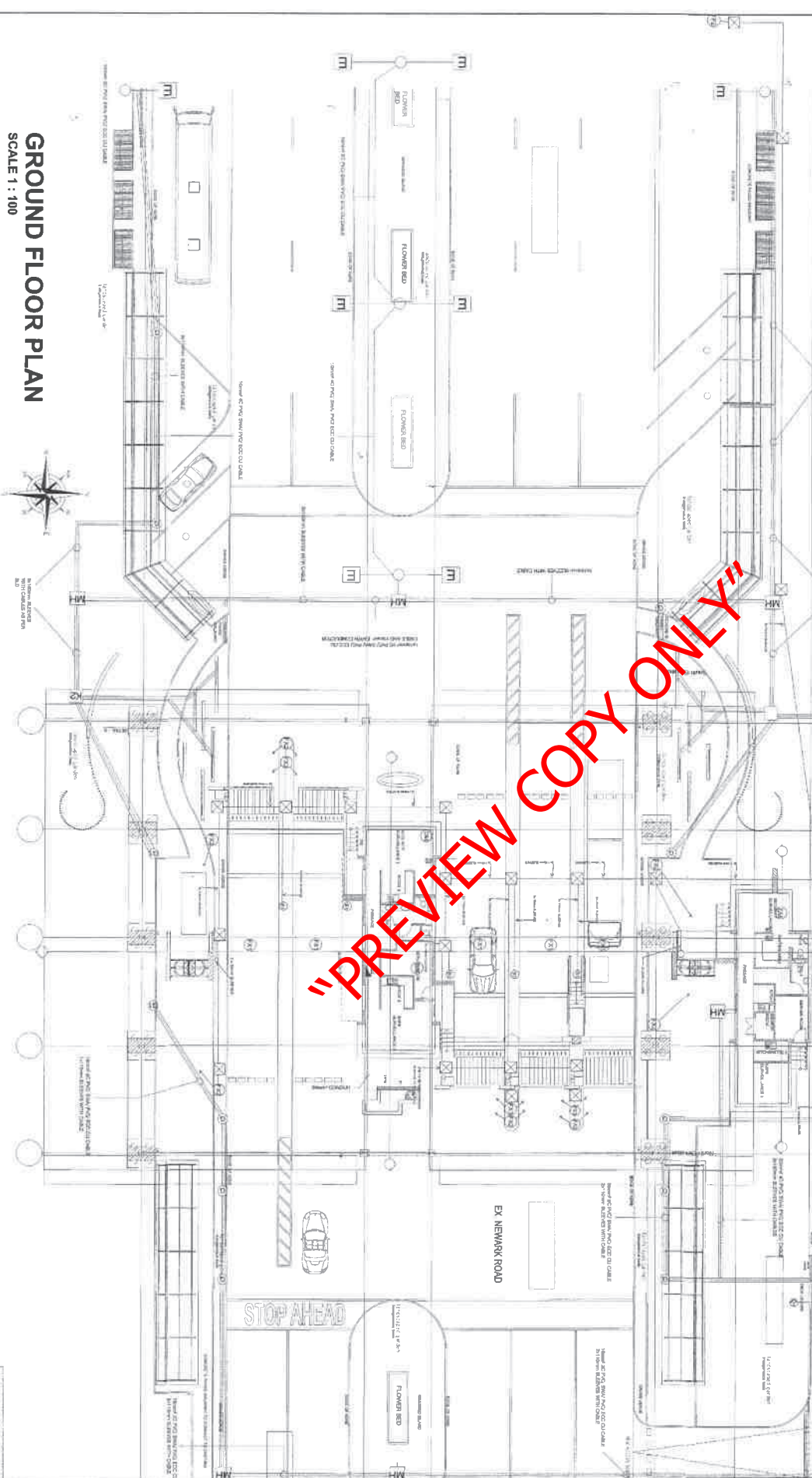


Figure 1: Typical layout of a 1000 sq ft room. The diagram shows a rectangular room with dimensions 20'0" x 30'0". It includes a door on the right wall, a window on the left wall, and a desk area on the right wall. The room is labeled "1000 sq ft" and "1000 sq ft".
